

Question of the Month Question: Does salt relieve itchy mosquito bites?

Answer: Believe it or not, the best way to treat a mosquito bite: lick the end of your finger to wet it then pour salt on it. Rub this onto the bite. This supplies sodium to the site as well as "scratching" it. Leave it alone (with the small amount of salt and moisture from your saliva) and forget about it. My grandfather told me this as a kid some 45 years ago. Trust me, it works 100% every time. Try it yourself and see. Also, if you ever get poison ivy or sumac poisoning on your skin there is a product that is absolutely a life saver. It's called "Tecnu" and it saved me from a horrible sumac case on my legs.
