



Dear Mr. Trevino:

The General Land Office has reviewed the application for a dune protection permit and beachfront construction certificate for the above-referenced location. The applicant proposes to construct an elevated wooden walkway to be located from the rear property line and retaining wall seaward to the vegetation line. According to the Bureau of Economic Geology, the proposed construction is located in an area that is accreting.

Based on the materials forwarded to our office for review, we have the following comments:

- The applicant must first avoid and then mitigate for any adverse effects to dunes or dune vegetation.<sup>1</sup>
- Construction activities must not impact the public's ability to access or use the beach.
- The City should require the applicant to restrict the seaward terminus of the walkway to the most landward point of the public beach<sup>2</sup> and should ensure that the walkover will not interfere with or otherwise restrict public use of the beach at normal high tides.<sup>3</sup>
- The walkway height should be at least one to one and a half times its width (three feet minimum) to allow sunlight to reach vegetation underneath. The deck of the walkway must be of sufficient elevation to allow for the growth of dune vegetation and the migration of dunes to the greatest extent practicable.<sup>4</sup>

• The City must ensure the proposed activity will minimize impacts on natural hydrology and will not cause erosion of adjacent properties, critical dune areas, or the public beach.<sup>5</sup>
