

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS; ESTABLISHING THE AD VALOREM AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2017-2018, AND SETTING THE ASSESSED VALUATION AT ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE AND PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS IN THE EVENT OF EARLY PAYMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a tax rate of \$0.315640 for each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of assessed valuation on all ad valorem and personal property taxable under the laws of this State by the City of South Padre Island and said Municipal Tax is levied and fixed for the following purposes, to wit:

First: An annual tax of \$0.249640 for each \$100.00 worth of property within the limits of the City of South Padre Island, which is made taxable by law either for State or County purposes, is hereby levied and fixed for the current expenditures of the City of South Padre Island, Texas, and for the general improvements of the City and its property.

Second: A tax of \$0.066000 for each \$100.00 worth of all property within the limits of The City of South Padre Island, Texas, which is made taxable by law, either for State or County purposes, is hereby levied and fixed for the purposes of creating an interest and sinking fund for the retirement of general obligation bond.

SECTION 2. There is hereby granted a discount for early payment of the 2017 taxes, which discount shall be: three per cent (3%) on 2017 taxes paid during the month of October 2017; two percent (2%) on 2017 taxes paid during the month of November 2017; and one percent (1%) on 2017 taxes paid during the month of December 2017.

SECTION 3. Any payment not timely made shall bear such penalty and interest as is provided by state law.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon the Second Reading.



Thank you for this opportunity to submit a proposal to the City of South Padre Island (City) for the pre-storm survey services for the City of South Padre Island. Pursuant to recent discussions, the City is requesting a pre-storm condition survey of the City of South Padre Island beaches. This survey varies in scope to the regular monitoring surveys performed for the City and Texas General Land Office due to time constraints caused by anticipated storm arrival dates. The project will be performed under the existing Multiple Project Agreement (MPA) between the City of South Padre Island and HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR), dated June 16, 2010 (attached). The following provides a scope of services to perform the requested work:

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Task 1: Closure-Depth Pre-Storm Condition Beach Profile Survey

HDR will conduct a closure-depth beach profile survey supported by use of a sea sled, personal watercraft, and/or other suitable methods for surveying in the surf zone and deep water. Spacing between the monuments listed above varies from approximately 1,000 feet to 1,300 feet. Survey transects will extend from the building line out to a depth of 25 to 30 feet. Survey shots along each section will be taken at approximately 10 feet to 20 feet maximum spacing, although shot spacing will be less as required to delineate significant bathymetric features. State coastal boundary delineation or other surveying of the vegetation line are not included.

1. STANDARD OF PERFORMANCE

The standard of care for all professional engineering, consulting and related services performed or furnished by ENGINEER and its employees under this Agreement will be the care and skill ordinarily used by members of ENGINEER's profession practicing under the same or similar circumstances at the same time and in the same locality. ENGINEER makes no warranties, express or implied, under this Agreement or otherwise, in connection with ENGINEER's services.

2. INSURANCE

3. OPINIONS OF PROBABLE COST (COST ESTIMATES)

Any opinions of probable project cost or probable construction cost provided by ENGINEER are made on the basis of information available to ENGINEER and on the basis of ENGINEER's experience and qualifications, and represents its judgment as an experienced and qualified professional engineer. However, since ENGINEER has no control over the cost of labor, materials, equipment or services furnished by others, or over the contractor(s') methods of determining prices, or over competitive bidding or market conditions, ENGINEER does not guarantee that proposals, bids or actual project or construction cost will not vary from opinions of probable cost ENGINEER prepares.

4. CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES

This Agreement is to be governed by the law of the state where ENGINEER's services are performed.

6. SERVICES AND INFORMATION

OWNER will provide all criteria and information pertaining to OWNER's requirements for the project, including design objectives and constraints, space, capacity and performance requirements, flexibility and expandability, and any budgetary limitations. OWNER will also provide copies of any OWNER-furnished Standard Details, Standard

Specifications, or Standard Bidding Documents which are to be incorporated into the project.

OWNER will furnish the services of soils/geotechnical engineers or other consultants that include reports and appropriate professional recommendations when such services are deemed necessary by ENGINEER. The OWNER agrees to bear full responsibility for the technical accuracy and content of OWNER-furnished documents and services.

In performing professional engineering and related services hereunder, it is understood by OWNER that ENGINEER is not engaged in rendering any type of legal, insurance or accounting services, opinions or advice. Further, it is the OWNER's sole responsibility to obtain the advice of an attorney, insurance counselor or accountant to protect the OWNER's legal and financial interests. To that end, the OWNER agrees that OWNER or the OWNER's representative will examine all studies, reports, sketches, drawings, specifications, proposals and other documents, opinions or advice prepared or provided by ENGINEER, and will obtain the advice of an attorney, insurance counselor or other consultant as the OWNER deems necessary to protect the OWNER's interests before OWNER takes action or lorebears to take action based upon or relying upon the services provided by ENGINEER.

7. SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS

OWNER and ENGINEER, respectively, bind themselves, their partners, successors, assigns, and legal representatives to the covenants of this Agreement. Neither OWNER nor ENGINEER will assign, sublet, or transfer any interest in this Agreement or claims arising therefrom without the written consent of the other.

8. RE-USE OF DOCUMENTS

All documents, including all reports, drawings, specifications, computer software or other items prepared or furnished by ENGINEER pursuant to this Agreement, are instruments of service with respect to the project. ENGINEER retains ownership of all such documents. OWNER may retain copies of the documents for its information and reference in connection with the project; however, none of the documents are intended or represented to be suitable for reuse by OWNER or others on extensions of the project or on any other project. Any reuse without written verification or adaptation by ENGINEER for the specific purpose intended will be at OWNER's sole risk and without liability or legal exposure to ENGINEER, and OWNER will defend, indemnify and hold harmless ENGINEER from all claims, damages, losses and expenses, including attorney's fees, arising or resulting therefrom. Any such verification or adaptation will entitle ENGINEER to further compensation at rates to be agreed upon by OWNER and ENGINEER.

9. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

OWNER or ENGINEER may terminate the Agreement, in whole or in part, by giving seven (7) days written notice, if the other party substantially falls to fulfill its obligations under the Agreement through no fault of the terminating party. Where the method of payment is "lump sum," or cost reimbursement, the final invoice will include all services and expenses associated with the project up to the effective date of termination. An equitable adjustment shall also be made to provide for termination settlement costs ENGINEER incurs as a result of commitments that had become firm before termination, and for a reasonable profit for services performed.

10. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this agreement is held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall be valid and binding upon the parties. One or more waivers by either party of any provision, term or condition shall not be construed by the other party as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same provision, term or condition.

11. INVOICES

ENGINEER will submit monthly invoices for services rendered and OWNER will make prompt payments in response to ENGINEER's invoices.

ENGINEER will retain receipts for reimbursable expenses in general accordance with Internal Revenue Service rules pertaining to the support of expenditures for income tax purposes. Receipts will be available for inspection by OWNER's auditors upon request.

If OWNER disputes any items in ENGINEER's Invoice for any reason, including the lack of supporting documentation, OWNER may temporarily delete the disputed item and pay the remaining amount of the invoice. OWNER will promptly notify ENGINEER of the dispute and request clarification and/or correction. After any dispute has been settled, ENGINEER will include the disputed item on a subsequent, regularly scheduled invoice, or on a special invoice for the disputed item only.

OWNER recognizes that late payment of invoices results in extra expenses for ENGINEER. ENGINEER retains the right to assess OWNER interest at the rate of one percent (1%) per month, but not to exceed the maximum rate allowed by law, on invoices which are not paid within thirty (30) days from the date of the invoice. In the event undisputed portions of ENGINEER's invoices are not paid when due, ENGINEER also reserves the right, after seven (7) days prior written notice, to suspend the performance of its services under this Agreement until all past due amounts have been paid in full.

12. CHANGES

The parties agree that no change or modification to this Agreement, or any attachments hereto, shall have any force or effect unless the change is reduced to writing, dated, and made part of this Agreement. The execution of the change shall be authorized and signed in the same manner as this Agreement. Adjustments in the period of services and in compensation shall be in accordance with applicable paragraphs and sections of this Agreement. Any proposed fees by ENGINEER are estimates to perform the services required to complete the project as ENGINEER understands it to be defined. For those projects involving conceptual or process development services, activities often are not fully definable in the initial planning. In any event, as the project progresses, the facts developed may dictate a change in the services to be performed, which may alter the scope. ENGINEER will Inform OWNER of such situations so that changes in scope and adjustments to the time of performance and compensation can be made as required. If such change, additional services, or suspension of services results in an increase or decrease in the cost of or time required for performance of the services, an equitable adjustment shall be made, and the Agreement modified accordingly.

13. CONTROLLING AGREEMENT

These Terms and Conditions shall take precedence over any inconsistent or contradictory provisions contained in any proposal, contract, purchase order, requisition, notice-to-proceed, or like document.

14. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT AND NONDISCRIMINATION

In connection with the services under this Agreement, ENGINEER agrees to comply with the applicable provisions of federal and state Equal Employment Opportunity for individuals based on color, religion, sex, or national origin, or disabled veteran, recently separated veteran, other protected veteran and armed forces service medal veteran status, disabilities under provisions of executive order 11246, and other employment, statutes and regulations, as stated in Title 41 Part 60 of the Code of Federal Regulations § 60-1.4 (a-f), § 60-300.5 (a-e), § 60-741 (a-e).

15. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

OWNER represents to ENGINEER that, to the best of its knowledge, no hazardous materials are present at the project site. However, in the event hazardous materials are known to be present, OWNER represents that to the best of its knowledge it has disclosed to ENGINEER the existence of all such hazardous materials, including but not limited to asbestos, PCB's, petroleum, hazardous waste, or radioactive material located at or near the project site, including type, quantity and location of such hazardous

materials. It is acknowledged by both parties that ENGINEER's scope of services do not include services related in any way to hazardous materials. In the event ENGINEER or any other party encounters undisclosed hazardous materials, ENGINEER shall have the obligation to notify OWNER and, to the extent required by law or regulation, the appropriate governmental officials, and ENGINEER may, at its option and without liability for delay, consequential or any other damages to OWNER, suspend performance of services on that portion of the project affected by hazardous materials until OWNER; (i) retains appropriate specialist consultant(s) or contractor(s) to identify and, as appropriate, abate, remediate, or remove the hazardous materials; and (ii) warrants that the project site is in full compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. OWNER acknowledges that ENGINEER is performing professional services for OWNER and that ENGINEER is not and shall not be required to become an "arranger," "operator," "generator," or "transporter" of hazardous materials, as defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1990 (CERCLA), which are or may be encountered at or near the project site in connection with ENGINEER's services under this Agreement. If ENGINEER's services hereunder cannot be performed because of the existence of hazardous materials. ENGINEER shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement for cause on 30 days written notice. To the fullest extent permitted by law, OWNER shall indemnify and hold harmless ENGINEER, its officers, directors, partners, employees, and subconsultants from and against all costs, losses, and damages (including but not limited to all fees and charges of engineers, architects, attorneys, and other professionals, and all court or arbitration or other dispute resolution costs) caused by, arising out of or resulting from hazardous materials, provided that (I) any such cost, loss, or damage is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease, or death, or injury to or destruction of tangible property (other than completed Work), including the loss of use resulting therefrom, and (ii) nothing in this paragraph shall obligate OWNER to indemnify any individual or entity from and against the consequences of that individual's or entity's sole negligence or willful misconduct.

16. EXECUTION

This Agreement, including the exhibits and schedules made part hereof, constitute the entire Agreement between ENGINEER and OWNER, supersedes and controls over all prior written or oral understandings. This Agreement may be amended, supplemented or modified only by a written instrument duly executed by the parties.

17. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

ENGINEER's and its employees' total liability to OWNER for any loss or damage, including but not limited to special and consequential damages arising out of or in connection with the performance of services or any other cause, including ENGINEER's and its employees' professional negligent acts, errors, or omissions, shall not exceed the greater of \$50,000 or the total compensation received by ENGINEER hereunder, except as otherwise provided under this Agreement, and OWNER hereby releases and holds harmless ENGINEER and its employees from any liability above such amount.

18. LITIGATION SUPPORT

In the event ENGINEER is required to respond to a subpoena, government inquiry or other legal process related to the services in connection with a legal or dispute resolution proceeding to which ENGINEER is not a party, OWNER shall relimburse ENGINEER for reasonable costs in responding and compensate ENGINEER at its then standard rates for reasonable time incurred in gathering information and documents and attending depositions, hearings, and trial.

19. UTILITY LOCATION

If underground sampling/testing is to be performed, a local utility locating service shall be contacted to make arrangements for all utilities to determine the location of underground utilities. In addition, OWNER shall notify ENGINEER of the presence and location of any underground utilities located on the OWNER's property which are not the responsibility of private/public utilities. ENGINEER shall take reasonable precautions to avoid damaging underground utilities that are properly marked. The OWNER agrees to waive any claim against

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ENGINEER and will indemnify and hold ENGINEER harmless from any claim of liability, injury or loss caused by or allegedly caused by ENGINEER's damaging of underground utilities that are not properly marked or are not called to ENGINEER's attention prior to beginning the underground sampling/testing.

This Task Order shall not be binding until it has been properly signed by both parties. Upon execution, this Task Order shall supplement the Agreement as it pertains to the project described below.

TASK ORDER NUMBER: 7

PROJECT NAME: 2017 Pre-Storm Condition Beach Profile Survey

PART 1.0 PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Project will perform a pre-storm condition survey in order to provide a comparison for post-storm impact and erosion calculations.

PART 2.0 SCOPE OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY CONSULTANT ON THE PROJECT:

PART 2.1: CONSULTANT will conduct a closure-depth beach profile survey supported by use of a sea sled, personal watercraft, and/or other suitable methods for surveying in the surf zone and deep water. The survey will extend approximately 5.2 miles north from the north jetty at Brazos Santiago Pass and consist of 26 beach cross sections collected alongshore.

Survey transect locations will re-occupy historical stations at Conrad Blucher Institute (CBI) monuments 1 through 25, with and additional transect between monuments CBI1 and CBI2. Spacing between the monuments listed above varies from approximately 1,000 feet to 1,300 feet. Survey transects will extend from the building line out to a depth of 25 to 30 feet. Survey shots along each section will be taken at approximately 10 feet to 20 feet maximum spacing, although shot spacing will be less as required to delineate significant bathymetric features. State coastal boundary delineation or other surveying of the vegetation line are not included. The survey data will be provided as a data file for use and comparison at a later date with post-storm survey data (if needed).

PART 3.0 OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

3.1 Provide CONSULTANT with available information on the project to enable the CONSULTANT to perform the Scope of Work.

- 3.2 Be available to respond to inquiries from the CONSULTANT in a timely fashion.
- 3.3 If appropriate, provide CONSULTANT with access to the property and be available to accompany the CONSULTANT to the site when needed.

PART 4.0 PERIODS OF SERVICE:

4.1 CONSULTANT shall be available to begin work after the execution of this Task Order and will endeavor to complete the work within 90 days of execution of this Task Order.

PART 5.0 PAYMENTS TO CONSULTANT:

5.1 OWNER shall pay the CONSULTANT on a lump sum basis. The estimated cost of this Task Order is \$31,000. CONSULTANT shall not exceed this amount without prior authorization from OWNER.

78. What procedure must cities use to obtain the services of a lawyer or the services of a law firm?

With the exception of certain bond counsel, state law does not specify any particular procedures for obtaining the services of a lawyer or of a law firm. The Professional Services Procurement Act does not apply to attorneys, ²⁰⁶ and the selection of an attorney is exempt from competitive bidding requirements as a "professional service." Thus, a city may choose to obtain the services of an attorney with or without the use of competitive bidding. Many cities simply hire their legal counsel by majority vote of the city's governing body and then execute a contract for such services. Cities should consult their current counsel for advice about this issue. When procuring the services of bond counsel, a city should review and comply with, if necessary, section 1201.027 of the Government Code, which requires that the selection of bond counsel shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Professional Services Procurement Act that apply to the selection of an engineer.

79. Are contracts for planning services exempt from competitive bidding requirements?

Texas law specifically exempts contracts for planning services from the competitive bidding requirements.²⁰⁹ However, it is important to note that the phrase "planning services" is specifically defined by Chapter 252. That term means "services primarily intended to guide governmental policy to ensure the orderly and coordinated development of the state or of municipal, county, metropolitan or regional land areas."²¹⁰ In order to be eligible for the planning services exception to the competitive bidding requirements, the planning services to be procured must fit this definition.

80. Does competitive bidding apply to services performed by blind or severely disabled persons?

Competitive bidding does not apply to the purchase of services performed by blind or severely disabled persons.²¹¹

Exceptions for Items Available from Only One Source

81. Does competitive bidding apply to the purchase of items that are available from only one source because of copyrights or "natural monopolies"?

Competitive bidding requirements do not apply to items that are available from only one source due to "patents, copyrights, secret processes, or natural monopolies." For example, at least one
