SOUTH PADRE ISLAND RED TIDE STATUS

South Padre Island, TX – October 1, 2015: Red tide cell concentrations are remaining steady on South Padre Island as city officials continue to monitor this situation.

The impact of red tide on the shoreline seems to be improving daily; no respiratory issues were reported to officials today and fish kill numbers continue to decrease. “Conditions overall seem to be improving. We’re going to continue monitoring this so that we can provide everyone with a safe environment,” said Rueben Trevino, Coastal Resources and Parks Administrator.

City crews are still cleaning the beaches every morning to ensure their safety.

Sandcastle Days, happening October 2-4, and the SPI Triathlon, happening October 4, remain scheduled to take place this weekend as planned.
