### **Auto pedestrian accident update**

**South Padre Island, TX, Mar. 17, 2017:** The South Padre Island Police Department has two females in custody believed to be involved in the early morning auto pedestrian accident on Mar. 17, 2017. A tip was received from a community member, which led to locating the suspect vehicle, a dark CR-V. The vehicle was still on South Padre Island.

"We feel confident that this is the vehicle involved in the accident," said Chief Randy Smith. "However, the investigation is still ongoing."

The primary suspect is a 20-year old female from Sugarland, Texas.

### **Auto pedestrian accident**

On Mar. 17, 2017 around 12:40 a.m. South Padre Island Police dispatch received a call concerning an auto pedestrian accident at the 4200 Block of Gulf Boulevard.

Emergency responders arrived within minutes and found three victims in the roadway with what appeared to be serious injuries and two others on the side of the roadway with minor injuries. The victims ranged in ages from 16 to 22 years old. The suspect vehicle had fled the scene before officers arrived.

The victims were transported by EMS to local hospitals and detectives are actively investigating. Based on evidence collected at the scene and witness statements, the suspect vehicle is believed to be a black or dark colored Honda CR-V or Pilot, which should have frontend damage (similar pictures below).
