Below are some tips for the community and short-term renter owners:

- Get to know your neighbors.
- Start a neighborhood watch on your street.
- Learn which homes are short-term rentals and who to contact for issues that may arise by searching [HERE](#).
- Tell a neighbor when you are out of town.
- Notify a neighbor if others will be at your house.
- Contract with a security company for regular checks on your property.
- Lock all doors and windows.
- Lock up vehicles and valuables.
- Avoid driving at peak times: 3 p.m. to midnight.
- Sign up for Swift911, the City's emergency notification system that sends out notifications directly to you via your home phone, cell phone and/or email, by clicking [HERE](#).
- For non-emergency situations call (956) 761-5454.
- For emergencies call 911.
- View registered rental properties and the contact person [HERE](#).
- Buy a smart monitor to alert you of how many people may be at your property.

- Confirm/update the emergency contact that is designated to respond to the property within one hour with a signed agreement regarding complaints from the City [HERE](#).
- List permit numbers on all advertisements of registered property.
