MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND

WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2023

1.CALL TO ORDER

The City Council Members of the City of South Padre Island, Texas held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, December 6, 2023 at the Municipal Complex Building, 2 Floor, 4601 Padre Boulevard, South Padre Island, Texas. Mayor McNulty called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A quorum was present: Mayor Patrick McNulty, Council Members Joe Ricco, Ken Medders, Jr., Kerry Schwartz and Rees Langston.

Mayor McNulty led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge.

3.INSTALLATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF OATH TO NEWLY ELECTED OFFICIALS:

3.1. NEWLY ELECTED MAYOR - PATRICK MCNULTY

Municipal Judge Edmund Cyganiewicz administered the Oath of Office to re-elected Mayor Patrick McNulty. Mayor McNulty then took his seat on the dais.

3.2. NEWLY ELECTED COUNCIL MEMBER, PLACE 4 - REES LANGSTON

Municipal Judge Edmund Cyganiewicz administered the Oath of Office to re-elected Council Member Rees Langston. Council Member Langston then took her seat on the dais.

5.APPROVE CONSENT AGENDA:

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Langston to approve the second and final reading of ordinance 23-13 by enacting a new Chapter 10, Article II, Sections 10-10 through 10-37, with exhibits A and B, related to food services

and Mobile Food Units, and repealing current Sections 10-10 through 10-33 of Chapter 10, Article II of the City of South Padre Island City Codes. Motion passed unanimously.

6.REGULAR AGENDA

6.1. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO PROVIDE A RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL REGARDING GULF GUARDIAN'S PROPOSAL TO START A PILOT PROJECT BY PLACING RECYCLING BINS ON THE CITY'S BEACHES. (BOBURKA)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve the proposed recycle bin on the beach pilot project, contingent upon the finalization of the agreement. Motion passed unanimously.

6.2. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER A CONTRACT WITH SOUTH TEXAS PALMS - ALTPW-6823 OR LAGUNA BOULEVARD PALM TREES OR WITH FR GREEN THUMB LANDSCAPING - PW01-2023 LAGUNA PALM TREES COST NOT TO EXCEED \$174,000.00. (SANCHEZ)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Langston to approve the City Manager to enter into a contract with South Texas Palms for 100 six to eight foot Dactyliferous palm trees. Motion passed unanimously.

6.3. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE 23-14 GRANTING AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER (AEP TEXAS INC.) ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE LINE AND APPURTENANCES AND APPLIANCES FOR CONDUCTING ELECTRICITY IN, OVER, UNDER, AND THROUGH THE STREETS, AVENUES, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC PLACES OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS. (MCNULTY)

Council Member Schwartz made a motion, seconded by Council Member Langston to approve the first reading of Ordinance 23-14 granting American Electric Power (AEP Texas Inc.) its successors and assigns a non-exclusive franchise to construct, maintain, and operate line and appurtenances and appliances for conducting electricity in, over, under, and through the streets, avenues, alleys, and public places of the City of South Padre Island, Texas. Motion passed unanimously.
