- Glass containers are prohibited on the beach.
- While enjoying the beach, stay hydrated and wear sunscreen.
- If the sand is too hot for your feet, it is too hot for your pet's paws.
- Observe beach signage for rip current status. Practice water safety.
- Don't swim alone; always use the buddy system. Swim near a lifeguard if possible.
- Open flames are prohibited on the beach.
- Report any suspicious activity to the South Padre Island Police Department at (956) 761-5454.
