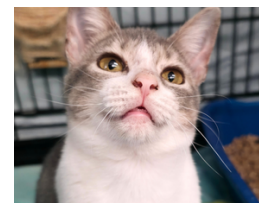

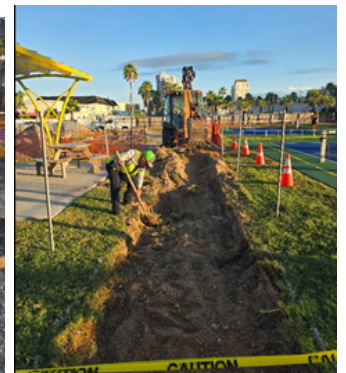
PR-100 Overflow Parking Facility Project

The PR-100 Overflow Parking Facility project began on October 20, 2025. The biggest part of the project is complete! Next up is the installation of decorative lamp poles and pedestrian crosswalk signals, and finishing the landscaping!



Pickleball Park

Phase #2 of the Pickleball Courts has been in progress. Recently, the foundations for the pergola and ADA bathroom were poured! Next up will be irrigation and the sodding of the grass. The final cherries on top will be the water fountain and a matching fence with the SPI Historical Museum.
