Bid is amended as follows:

1. Project Schedule

- a. Project schedule and construction days has been changed to 90 calendar days after Notice To Proceed.

2. Demolition

- a. All median islands to be demoed to 6" depth below top of curb and 12" depth in middle planting areas. 6" depth areas to receive filter fabric, boulders and washed gravel and 12" depth areas to receive topsoil/compost mix and shredded hardwood mulch as specified.
- b. During demo, contractor to adjust light fixture locations to gravel areas. PVC pieces around light fixtures to be removed.
- c. Existing irrigation valve boxes shall be relocated to gravel areas and painted to match gravel (beige/gray lid covers).
- d. Existing irrigation bubblers on palms to be removed and any laterals that connect bubblers back to the mainlines.

3. Concrete Pads

- a. Concrete pads for planters shall be 6" thick, 3000 psi, welded wire mesh and fiber mesh reinforced, with Sika Color-100 P (Butterfield) Uni-Mix color (Color to be U14-Pewter). 1 Bag per cubic yard of concrete.

4. Pavers (Alternate No. 1)

- a. Alternate No. 1 shall include lifting and resetting pavers that are depressed and replace pavers that are damaged. Reset pavers on clean sand and compact with plate compactor to be flush with top of curb and adjacent pavers. See Alternate No. 1 on bid form.

5. Revised Plans & Bid Form

- a. See attached revised sheets L1.00-L2.07 and revised bid form.
