- Approval of the first reading of Ordinance No. 26-02 renewing the Garbage and Trash Collection Franchise Republic Services until February 28, 2031.
- Approval of the first reading of Ordinance No. 26-03 amending Chapter 4: Buildings and Construction of the Code of Ordinances of the City of South Padre Island, as recommended by the Ad Hoc Committee and City Staff.
