MINUTES CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

WEDNESDAY, MAY 3, 2017

I. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council Members of the City of South Padre Island, Texas held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, May 3, 2017 at the Municipal Complex Building, 2nd Floor, 4601 Padre Boulevard, South Padre Island, Texas. Mayor Pro-tem Dennis Stahl called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A quorum was present: Council Members Ron Pitcock, Theresa Metty, Alita Bagley and Paul Munarriz, with Mayor Bharat Patel absent due to emergency travel. Council Member Metty made a motion, seconded by Council Member Pitcock to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

City Manager Susan Guthrie gave a brief update on the Venue Tax projects with Chief Financial Officer Rodrigo Gimenez giving a financial update and Silent Water Sport Enthusiast Carol Bolstad giving a rendition of proposed Water Sport facilities.

VIII. UPDATE AND DISCUSSION UPDATE ON SPRING BREAK: (GUTHRIE)

An update was given on subcommittees who met to discuss Spring Break/Mass Gathering and short-term rental/neighborhood issues. Transit Director Jesse Arriaga gave an update on the pilot program for Transit buses during high peak times, concluding that it worked very well.

IX. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE ORDINANCE NO. 17-03 AMENDING SECTION 4-27 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES PROHIBITING BARBED WIRE FENCING. (JONES)

Council Member Metty made a motion, seconded by Council member Bagley to approve first reading of Ordinance No. 17-03 prohibiting barbed wire fencing. Motion passed unanimously.

X. DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-04 AMENDING CHAPTER 10, ARTICLE II, FOOD SERVICES TO COMPLY WITH THE NEW CHANGES TO THE TEXAS FOOD ESTABLISHMENT RULES. (BALDOVINOS)

Council Member Bagley made a motion to approve first reading of Ordinance No. 17-04 to comply with new changes to the Texas Food Establishment rules. Motion was seconded by Council Member Pitcock, which carried on a unanimous vote.

XI. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-05 TO AMEND CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 10-31 PERTAINING TO MOBILE FOOD UNIT DESIGNATED AREAS AND PERMIT REQUIREMENTS. (BALDOVINOS)

Council Member Metty made a motion to approve first reading of Ordinance No. 17-05 pertaining to mobile food units designated areas and permit requirements. Council Member Pitcock seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

XII. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE NO. 17-06 AMENDING CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ALLOW FOR EXPANDED DESIGNATION FOR QUALIFIED NATURAL HABITAT LOTS. (BALDOVINOS)

Council Member Bagley made a motion, seconded by Council Member Metty to approve first reading of Ordinance No. 17-06 amending Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances to allow for expanded designation for Qualified Natural Habitat lots. Motion carried on a unanimous vote.

XIII. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE THE AMENDMENT TO MULTIPLE USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) AND THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, WHICH WILL PERMIT THE CITY'S TRANSIT DEPARTMENT TO CONSTRUCT A PERMANENT FACILITY ON AN ADDITIONAL PORTION OF THE STATE RIGHT OF WAY NECESSARY FOR THE STRUCTURE. (ARRIAGA)

Council Member Bagley made a motion to authorize the City Manager to approve the amendment to the Multiple Use Agreement to construct a permanent facility on additional State right-of-way. Motion was seconded Council Member Pitcock and passed unanimously.

XIV. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE THE STANDARD LEASE AGREEMENT FOR THE MULTIMODAL FACILITY, WHICH WILL ESTABLISH A COOPERATIVE AND MUTUALLY BENEFICIAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE OF TEXAS ACTING THROUGH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (TXDOT) AND THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND'S TRANSIT DEPARTMENT. (ARRIAGA)

Council Member Munarriz made a motion, seconded by Council Member Pitcock to approve lease agreement for Transit Multimodal facility. Motion carried on a unanimous vote.

XV. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$981,726 FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SEASIDE, OCEAN, MOONLIGHT AND GULF-END WALKOVERS. (B. HILL)

Mayor Pro-tem Stahl made a motion to approve budget amendment for the construction of Seaside, Ocean, Moonlight and Gulf-end walkovers in the amount of \$981,726. Council Member Munarriz seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

XVI. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AWARD BID FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF OCEAN CIRCLE BEACH ACCESS TO THE LOWEST BIDDER, GONZALEZ-DE LA GARZA & ASSOCIATES, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$452,000. (B. HILL)

Council Member Pitcock made a motion, seconded by Council Member Munarriz to award a contract for the development of Ocean Circle Beach Access to the lowest bidder meeting specifications, Gonzalez-De La Garza & Associates, LLC, in the amount of \$452,000. Motion carried on a unanimous vote.

Other bids received were from Bryant Industrial Services in the amount of \$564,000.

XVII. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AWARD BID TO CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK AND DUNE WALKOVER AT SEASIDE CIRCLE BEACH ACCESS TO THE LOWEST BIDDER, WILLIS DEVELOPMENT LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$298,690.20. (B. HILL)

Council Member Munarriz made a motion, seconded by Council Member Pitcock to award a contract to construct a sidewalk and dune walkover at Seaside Circle Beach Access to the lowest bidder meeting specifications, Willis Development LLC, in the amount of \$298,690.20. Motion carried on a unanimous vote.

Other bids received were from Bryant Industrial Services in the amount of \$307,000.

XVIII. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AWARD BID FOR THE WEST ARIES DRIVE AND WEST VERNA JEAN DRIVE WIDENING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT TO THE LOW BIDDER, G&T PAVING, LLC, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$158,811.74. (SANCHEZ)

Council Member Pitcock made a motion, seconded by Council Member Metty to award a contract for street widening improvements to West Aries and Verna Jean Drive to the lowest bidder meeting specifications, G & T Paving LLC, in the amount of \$158, 811.74. Motion carried on a unanimous vote.

XIX. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO APPOINT ASSISTANT CITY ATTORNEY KATHY CUNNINGHAM AS THE CITY ATTORNEY. (GUTHRIE)

Council Member Munarriz made a motion to appoint Kathy Cunningham as the City Attorney. Motion was seconded by Council Member Pitcock, which passed unanimously.
