


The City Council and the Shoreline Task Force approved City Beach Access 24 to be named Sunset Beach Access and the department will be creating signage.

Preliminary: EMS Calls for Service Comparison March 1 - March 21







Council Highlights

At the recent City Council meeting held on March 7, Quentin Anderson presented the City's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for fiscal year 2016-2017. This financial report is prepared from the books and records of the City of South Padre Island. The goal of this independent audit, conducted by Carr, Riggs & Ingram, LLC, was to provide reasonable assurance that the financial statements of the City was free of material misstatement. We would like to thank the Finance Department staff and the Department Directors for their diligent efforts in the preparation of the annual financial report. Also, we would like to thank the Mayor and Council Members for their leadership and support of the City that helped make the preparation of this report possible.

City Council also awarded the 2018 Street Reconstruction Project to REIM Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1,444,900.90. The improvements will include widening the streets to allow approximately 262 parking spaces to be added to the public right-of-way. Construction is scheduled to begin in April 2018 and the eight streets to be improved are:

East Verna Jean Drive East Polaris Drive East Jupiter Lane East Venus Lane East Lantana Street East Atol Street East Sunny Isle East White Sands Street (pending)


Beach & Dune Permits


