The contractor stopped work for the Labor Day holiday, and will finish up afterwards.
Landscape work at Bay street ends	Maintain landscape at the bay ends of the local streets	5.J	9/30/2011	9/30/2011	The contractor is installing landscaping at the west end of Marlin Street. This bay end has never had landscaping before.

Cora Lee Drainage	Install rip-rap at the end of the street to prevent erosion and install valley gutters at various locations to enhance drainage	5.H	1/11/2010	9/30/2011	The installation of the pipe at the bay end is on hold while we reconstruct the Palm St. boat ramp. We want to makell funds available until after the boat ramp project is complete. The valley gutters on the east side have been completed.
