At Schlitterbahn, staff had been waiting for the County to approve the installation (which occurred on 3/4). At the World Birding Center, the contractor had encountered numerous utility conflicts. He has since found a location where there are no utility conflicts. At the old Surf's Up site the property owner has decided not to go forward with the project. Transportation staff is currently seeking a new location for this shelter.
