Council Member Bagley made a motion to approve first reading of Ordinance No. 19-05 rescinding Ordinance No. 18-17 for the Special Use Permit for an outdoor amusement located at 1201 Padre Boulevard due to the condition of replacing the chain link fence with vinyl fencing by January 1, 2019 was not met. Mayor Stahl seconded the motion, which carried on a 3 to 2 vote with Council Members Medders and Dalton casting a nay vote.

# IX. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO ACCEPT AND MOVE FORWARD WITH PUBLIC WORKS RECOMMENDATIONS FOR SIDEWALK LANDSCAPING ON PADRE BOULEVARD AND RESCIND THE PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION. (BAGLEY)

## <u>INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN</u> THE COUNTY OF CAMERON AND THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into and between the COUNTY OF CAMERON, TEXAS, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and the CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", on this 8<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019, pursuant to the provisions of the Interlocal Cooperation Act.

WHEREAS, Cameron County is a county in the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, the City of South Padre Island is a home rule municipality located in Cameron County, Texas;

WHEREAS, County and City, each pursuant to its statutory and constitutional authority, are responsible for maintenance and operations along with improvements of certain venues, parks, and quality of life projects within their respective borders;

WHEREAS, City and County desire to provide and perform improvements including a feasibility study and other potential project development for a Cruise Ship Port of Call site in Cameron County and on South Padre Island.

WHEREAS, the project could potentially be located within county property at Isla Blanca Park;

WHEREAS, County and the City have determined that both entities will receive a mutual benefit from the proposed project, that such will serve a County and City purpose, and that permits the expenditure of County and City funds for such purpose;

WHEREAS, County and City are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code 791.001 et seq., Section 791.032;

WHEREAS, City, requests and authorizes the County to perform the work and services described herein within its corporate city limits and to be partially funded by the City.

- 1. LOCATION OF PROJECT: Cruise ship Port of Call Studies, South Padre Island, Texas at Cameron County Isla Blanca Park.
- 2. WORK AND SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED: Feasibility study and continued consulting services for purposes of analyzing and coordinating necessary work for predevelopment (studies, permits, etc.) of the necessary infrastructure at the proposed location(s).
- 3. City will be responsible for providing the funding in the amount of \$26,000.00 to initiate the feasibility study and continue the consulting services until current funding is no longer available. The City will work with the county to identify any potential future funding for project development. Funding could come from city or other sources. The proposed project

will occur on land owned by the county. The county under this Interlocal agreement may assist in providing funding for the development (design, permitting of the South Padre Island/Cameron County Cruise ship Port of Call). County will be responsible for coordinating the feasibility study and other activities associated with project development. It is specifically understood and agreed that additional funding may be requested for the project development once the feasibility study is complete. Cost estimates are subject to change and the County and City will make every effort to ensure changes and funding participation are made in conjunction with each other.

- 4. The execution and performance of this Agreement by County and City have been duly authorized by all necessary laws, resolutions or corporate action, and this Agreement constitutes the valid and enforceable obligations of the County and the City in accordance with its terms.
- 5. This Agreement constitutes a one-time agreement between the parties and does not constitute a continuing agreement or responsibility. Any future work to continue project development for the project will be the responsibility of the County in conjunction with the city.
- 6. Each party agrees to conform to its own applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures with respect to the performance of the work and services under this Agreement. The Agreement shall have no legal force or effect until such time as it is properly adopted and approved by the CAMERON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT and CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND CITY COUNCIL. This Agreement shall terminate on completion of the project.
- 7. The parties agree that the County will be released of any and all duties imposed by this Agreement following completion of the work and service described in this Agreement.
- 8. All expenditures made under this Agreement will be made from the current revenues of the paying party.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 19-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE 18-17 THAT PROVIDED THE SPECIFIC USE PERMIT FOR OUTDOOR AMUSEMENT AT PADRE ISLAND UNSUBDIVIDED ABST 260 AND THEREBY REVOKING SAID SPECIFIC USE PERMIT DUE TO NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS PROVIDED IN THE SPECIFIC USE PERMIT; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION IN CAPTION FORM.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of South Padre Island ("City Council"), conducted a public hearing on May 16, 2018 wherein a request was made by Doyle Wells (the "Applicant") to allow a Specific Use Permit for "Outdoor Amusement" operations on a tract of land zoned District "PBS" (Padre Boulevard South);

**WHEREAS**, the tracts of land subject to the Specific Use Permit are in the City of South Padre Island, Texas, being PADRE ISLAND UNSUBDIVIDED ABST 260 3.605 AC OUT OF 6.675 AC PT LT AN-7 BLK A, and being more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes (the "Property");

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Applicant has failed to construct a vinyl fence by January 1, 2019 as required by Ordinance 18-17 and therefore has failed to comply with the requirements of the Specific Use Permit granted therein; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 18-17 provides that the Specific Use Permit as provided therein will be declared null and void upon, among other things, the failure to comply with any term of the ordinance;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

- **Section 1.** The findings set forth above are incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2.** The locations of the Specific Use Permit are referenced on the Zoning Map as shown on Exhibit "A".
- **Section 3.** On May 16, 2018 Applicant was granted a Specific Use Permit to allow operation of the identified outdoor amusement facility based upon the following conditions:
  - 1. Expansion of current operations is limited to the addition of amusement amenities attached in Exhibit "B";
  - 2 The maximum number of rides that may be permitted on the property shall be 9, excluding
    Page 1 of 9

the Zip Line;

# 3. The applicant shall replace the chain link fencing with vinyl fencing by January 1, 2019;

- 4. The applicant shall ensure each amusement ride is inspected annually by a licensed amusement ride inspector, as registered by the Texas Department of Insurance;
- 5. Proper and on-going maintenance shall be performed to include removal of any visible rust and chipping paint;
- 6. This Specific Use Permit shall be retained with the property upon transfer of ownership;
- 7. In the event an amusement ride is replaced with another, the replacement ride shall not exceed the overall dimensions of the previous ride;
- **Section 4.** Applicant has failed to comply with condition 3, noted in Section 3.

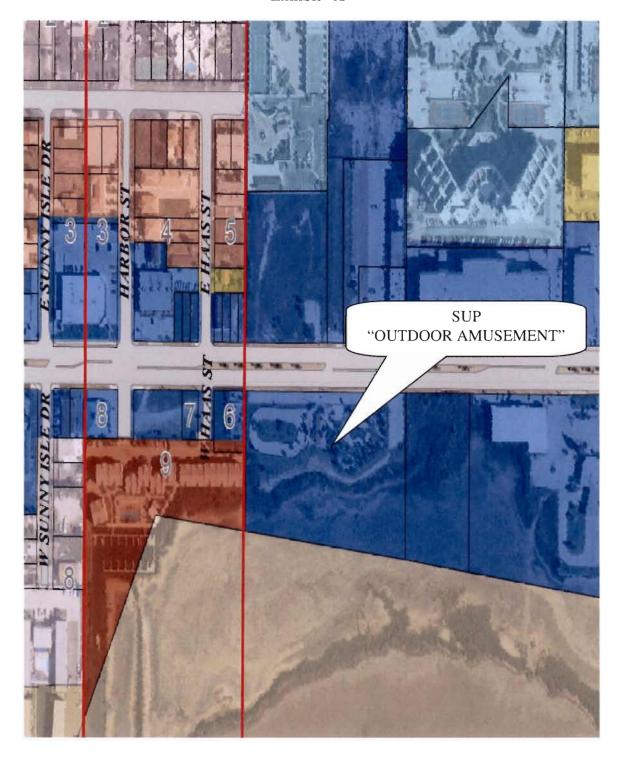
**Section 5.** This Specific Use Permit is hereby revoked due to failure to comply with the conditions set forth.

**Section 6.** This ordinance repeals all portions of any prior ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Code of Ordinances in conflict herewith.

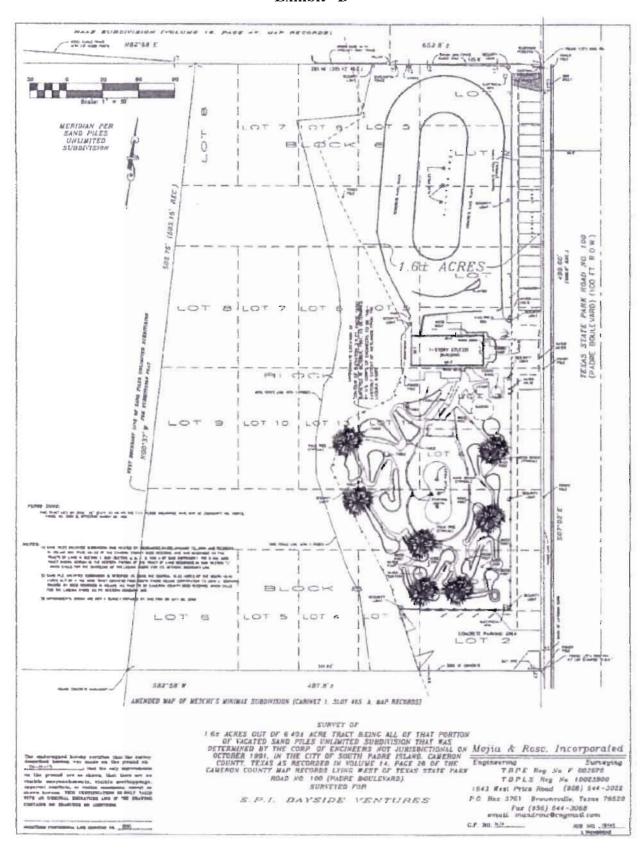

This information will allow stakeholders to understand the latest advances in the convention and public assembly venue industry and how they apply to the situation in South Padre Island.

In conjunction with Client representatives and other stakeholders, we will also select several comparable and competitive markets that have performed specific asset developments to maximize a return on investment and expanded the infrastructure to enter new markets. We will then interview facility management and compile statistical data on the size, quality, and performance of these facilities/ markets, including demand and operational information. Case study information on the comparable and competitive facilities will be summarized and analyzed in our report.

#### TASK 4 - IDENTIFICATION OF USER GROUPS/ SURVEYS & INTERVIEWS

Focusing on the convention market, we will work with Client Representatives to document major corporations, associations, event promoters, organizations, and institutions active in the region and nationally. We will identify past, current, and potential users and interview them regarding the need and desire for an expanded convention center in South Padre Island. We will have similar conversations with regional and national trade and consumer show producers, convention organizers, show promoters, and other relevant industry participants, as well as representatives of events that make the circuit through existing regional facilities.

We will ask specific questions regarding:

Amount, size, and attributes of exhibition space.





- Amount, size and attributes of ballroom space.
- Amount, size and attributes of meeting/breakout space.
- Hotel requirements.
- Technology requirements.
- Pricing requirements and strategies.
- Perceptions of the market and area of the City.
- Support facilities.
- Other criteria necessary to attract their patronage.

We will utilize a combination of interviews, focus groups and a web-based survey tool to gather input from past, current and potential users as well as local businesses and community organizations. This methodology will ensure that we have a clear and accurate understanding of perceptions of the need and desire for an enhanced convention center, the target markets for the venue to pursue, and the impact of potential development projects on facility demand.

#### TASK 5 - FACILITIES GAP ANALYSIS AND NICHE IDENTIFICATION UPDATE

During this task, we will analyze the findings obtained from the preceding tasks, resulting in a summary by type of existing and proposed facility and the type of event categories they each penetrate and will identify unmet needs and demands in the local area as well as any needs and demands in the broader regional and national markets. If we determine a "gap" exists in the market, we will evaluate the potential of a redeveloped facility and its required types and size of spaces to target the identified market opportunities. This task will conclude by presenting an area of opportunity analysis highlighting the size and quality level of the proposed redeveloped project relative to existing facilities and their sizes and quality levels.

To complete this task, we will update our previous analysis with the following tasks:

- The depth, quality, pricing structure, and market reach of the existing facility.
- Current and historical operations of the convention center in order to assess its demand and financial operating characteristics, advantages and disadvantages, and geographic draw, among other factors.

The market analysis will result in final recommendations regarding the appropriate facility program. Factors to be addressed include:

- Optimum size of the facility components.
- Support space.
- Equipment and operations storage.
- Dining, concessions and other customer related elements.
- Entrance and lobby areas.



- Parking.
- Adjacent land use opportunities.
- Urban Design.
- Other relevant aspects.

#### TASK 6 - UPDATED DEMAND PROJECTIONS

Based on the market analysis and performance of comparable facilities, the Consulting Team will develop event and demand attendance figures for different types of events that would be held at the expanded facility. This demand projection will specifically address the following:

- Event days by type of event.
- Attendance by event type.
- Special events.
- Achievable pricing levels.
- SMERF and non-sports demand, and
- Total use days.
- Room nights generated.
- Visitor spending.

We will provide demand projections for the proposed facility for a 10-year period.

#### TASK 7 - FINANCIAL PROJECTION UPDATE

The study will include an updated financial proforma statement for the finalized recommended facilities that summarizes a 10-year projection of revenues, expenses, and net operating income throughout the period of the projections. The Consulting Team will present the financial projection by the following categories (and others specific to this market) of revenues and expenses:

As appropriate, we may also offer a specific discussion regarding revenue sources that are available to facilities in Texas, including hotel tax rebates, TIF and other revenue sources.

#### TASK 8 - ECONOMIC & FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS (OPTIONAL)

Based on the Center's projected demand schedule and assumptions regarding origin of attendees, as well as the local and regional tax structure, our Consulting Team will project the economic, social and fiscal impacts that will accrue in the local market as a result of the annual operations at the convention center as well as the one-time construction impacts. The analysis will consider direct spending impacts, and indirect and induced impacts, fiscal impacts, and local employment and income impacts based on standard multipliers of direct impacts that are refined based on local market conditions.

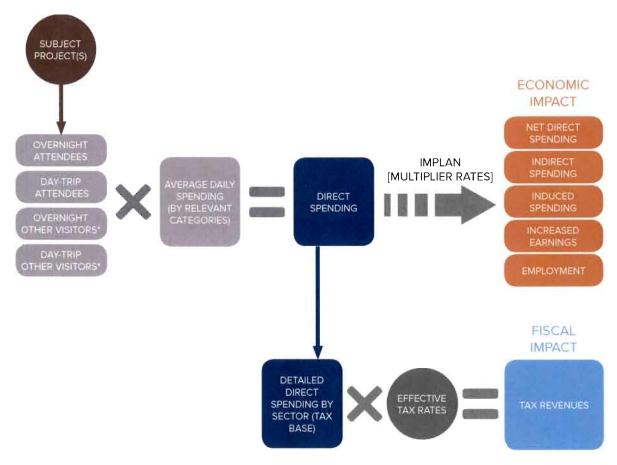
The presentation of our economic and fiscal impact analysis will include the following:

- BASELINE ASSUMPTIONS Our model will develop variables for visitor spending, promoter spending, attendee origin, and other information. From our discussions with event managers and collection of secondary data, our Consulting Team will have the necessary information on event attributes and attendee origin, attendee length of stay, percent of attendees who will likely stay overnight, and other significant variables.
- DIRECT SPENDING ESTIMATES The analysis will estimate the direct spending of attendees, show organizers, and promoters for use in the projections.
- FISCAL IMPACT ANALYSIS The fiscal impact analysis will quantify what the local (City and County) and state governments will receive from the development of the project. If applicable, we will estimate annual tax dollars returned to the state and local governments as a result of increased business activity and personal income associated with the construction and operation of the facility.
- INDUCED ECONOMIC IMPACTS Hotels, restaurants, surrounding businesses, and event organizers want to see what this facility will offer in relation to their existing operations. We will quantify what the facility will mean to these types of businesses if new facilities are developed. The economic impact analysis will also include a refined projection of the incremental number of annual room nights generated by the facility's demand, based on event and attendee characteristics and the projected demand schedules. For indirect and induced spending we use Implan to develop the multiplier rates. Implan is a nationally recognized and generally accepted input-output model that is specific to the subject area's economy.

Definitions and Key Terms used in Economic and Fiscal Impacts:

Economic Impact – is defined as incremental new spending in an economy that is the direct





result of certain activities, facilities, or events. For the purpose of this analysis, impact totals are discussed in terms of Fairbanks economy. The levels of impacts are described as follows:

- **Direct Spending** is an expression of the spending that occurs as a direct result of the events that occur in the facility. For example, a performance attendee's expenditures on hotel rooms, shopping, and meals are direct spending.
- Indirect Spending consists of re-spending of the initial or direct expenditures, or, the supply of goods and services resulting from the initial direct spending in the performing arts center. For example, a performance attendee's direct expenditure on a restaurant meal causes the restaurant to purchase food and other items from suppliers. The portion of these restaurant purchases that are within the local, regional, or state economies is counted as an indirect spending.
- Induced Spending represent changes in local consumption due to the personal spending by employees whose incomes are affected by direct and indirect spending. For example, a waiter at the restaurant may have more personal income as a result of the ball game attendee's visit. The amount of the increased income the waiter spends in the local economy is called an induced spending.
- Increased Earnings measures increased employee and worker compensation related to the project being analyzed. This figure represents increased payroll expenditures, including benefits paid to workers locally. It also expressed how the employees of local businesses share



in the increased outputs.

 Employment – measures the number of jobs supported in the study area related to the spending generated as a result of the game and events occurring in the performing arts center.
 Employment impact is stated in a number of full-time equivalent jobs.

### REPORTS AND MEETINGS

#### **ORDINANCE NO. 19-06**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS; AMENDING THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR 2018 - 2019 OPERATING BUDGET TO INCORPORATE PRIOR BUDGET AMENDMENTS AND BUDGET MODIFICATIONS FOR THE MONTHS OF OCTOBER 2018 THROUGH FEBRUARY 2019.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 18-20 the City of South Padre Island (the "<u>City</u>") adopted the budget for the City for the fiscal year 2018 - 2019 (the "<u>Budget</u>), which provides funding for the City's operations throughout said fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City needs to adjust the Budget for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, City staff has recommended that the City Council of the City adjust the Budget as provided for herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to adjust the Budget as provided for herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City's Budget is hereby adjusted as follows:

- Increase General Fund expenditures by \$622,425.71
- Increase General Fund revenues by \$328,208.71
- Increase Hotel Motel Fund expenditures by \$1,475,000
- Increase Convention Centre Fund expenditures by \$60,000
- Increase Forfeiture Fund expenditures by \$7,000
- Increase Parks, Recreation & Beautification expenditures by \$5,000
- Increase Parks, Recreation & Beautification revenues by \$5,000
- Increase Padre Blvd Improvement Fund expenditures by \$41,386.90
- Increase Beach Maintenance Fund expenditures by \$337,883
- Increase Beach Access Fund expenditures by \$150,883
- Increase Beach Access Fund revenues by \$150,883

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance repeals all portions of any prior ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Code of Ordinances in conflict herewith and shall not be codified.

<u>Section 3.</u> If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any other section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this Ordinance for it is the definite intent of this City Council that every section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision hereof be given full force and effect for its purpose.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
