Re: Request that current Cross-Border Travel Restrictions be terminated or allowed to expire on or about June 22, 2020 to avoid further economic hardship <u>and</u> to allow visitors from Mexico and Canada to use and enjoy <u>their property</u> at South Padre Island, Texas.

Dear Secretary Wolf:

As the United States and the State of Texas continue to ease or eliminate business and travel restrictions, cross-border travel suspensions limiting entry into the United States from Mexico and Canada have remained in full force.

As Mayor of the City of South Padre Island, Texas, which is a resort destination on the Gulf of Mexico and only miles from the U.S. – Mexico border, and on behalf of our residents, property owners, and business owners, we respectfully request and strongly urge you to allow the current restrictions on non-essential travel between the United States, Mexico, and Canada to expire on or even before June 22, 2020.

The only industry on South Padre Island is tourism and economic hardship continues to occur in our community when visitors from Mexico and Canada are prohibited from traveling to South Padre Island.

Also, and as equally important, a substantial number of residences at South Padre Island are owned by Mexican residents who pay taxes and constitute an integral part of our community.

Under the current cross-border travel restrictions, the foreign citizens who own property and who have second homes at South Padre Island are being deprived of their fundamental rights to use and enjoy their own property.

I again strongly urge you, and respectfully request that the current cross-border travel restrictions be lifted.



Thank you in advance for your consideration on this vital matter to our community and to all cities along the U.S. – Mexico border.

We look forward to a positive response on this matter that is adversely impacting our city economically and currently depriving visitors from Mexico and Canada from using and enjoying their properties.

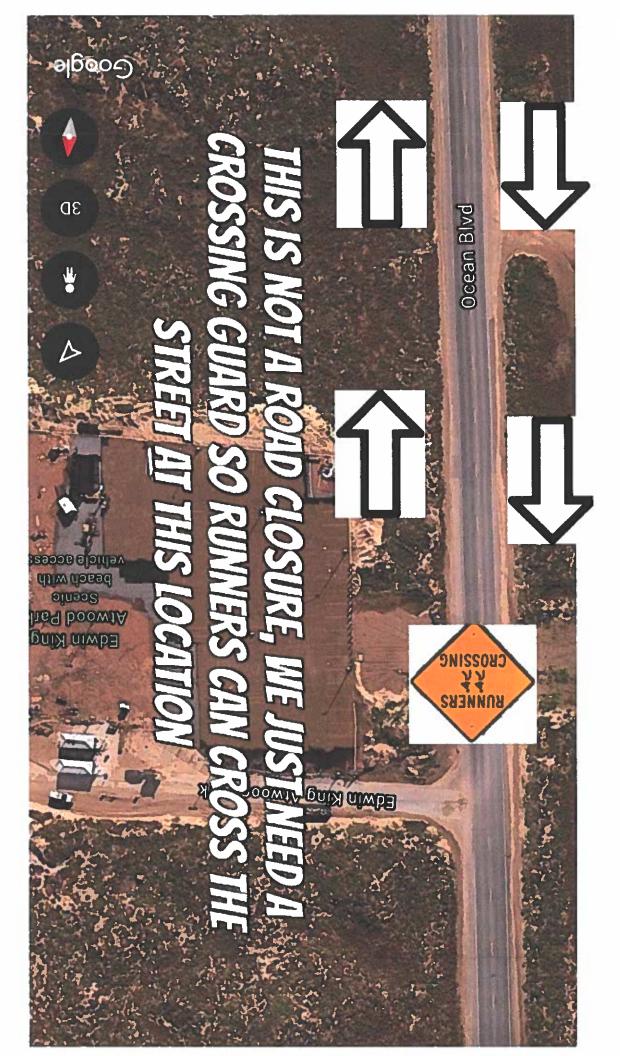

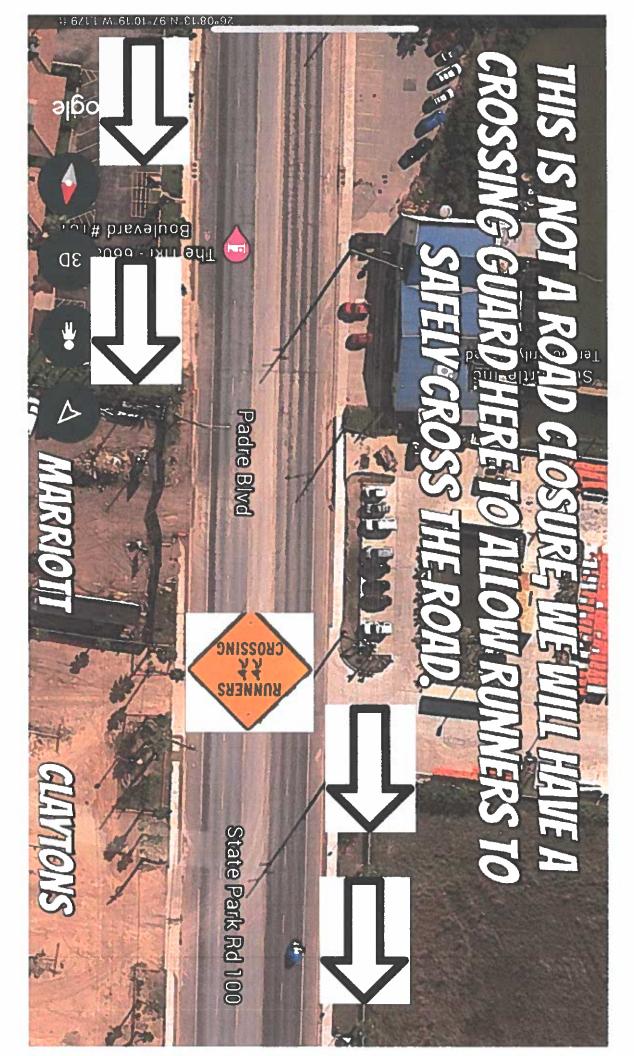

The City of South Padre Island (City) will utilize an innovative green living shoreline design for this project. The City is interested in a feasibility study and design concept to further the project's development. The project will contribute to protecting coastal communities with the added benefit of habitat restoration. The City plans to achieve these primary goals with the creation of wetland berms established alongside the Tompkins Channel within the Laguna Madre. The berms will increase beneficial ecology and create intertidal wetland pockets where marine vegetation can take hold and become deeply rooted. The presence of vegetated berms decreases wave energy from natural wind, tidal, seiche waves, and artificial marine transportation but most significantly from severe environmental stressors. The berms will further create a buffer from the eastern severe storm surge that can impact the mainland. Currently, hard grey structures such as bulkheads protect the bayside of the island causing a benthic deepening to the naturally shoaled waters. With this preventative shoreline, South Padre Island will decrease its bayside erosion rate. The incorporation of adaptation is the key to a successful long-term beneficial project. The City's adaptation plan will include the westerly growth of the berms in management of preventative storm surge care, support of wetland expansion, vegetation stock and planting needs during the early years of development, and elevated berms to combat accelerated sea-level rise.

c. **Project support and engagement:** Describe the community leaders, partners, and stakeholders engaged with the project.

Project support began in 2018 when the Texas General Land Office held a variety of stakeholder meetings to best understand what coastal communities needed in terms of large projects. While visiting the Rio Grande Valley, the Texas General Land Office took into consideration these projects and placed them in the 2019 Texas Coastal Resiliency Master Plan. Throughout this plan, several Tier 1 projects give priority in research, design, and development along the Texas coastline. Our project falls under two different scopes within Region 4 (the lower Texas coast). Project IDs R4-9 the Restoration of Barrier Island Bayside Wetlands and R4-11 the City of South Padre Island Living Shoreline. The Texas Coastal Resiliency Master Plan displays support and engagement from our stateside officials with whom the City works closely. Community leaders who support the project are the City Manager, City Mayor, and the City Council. They have all worked together alongside residents in determining what projects best serve the community.

The Laguna Madre Living Shoreline will be located at the southernmost coast of Texas, alongside the western boundary of the City of South Padre Island's Tompkins Channel which runs parallel to the bayside shoreline.

An assortment of methods will be used with the living shoreline project that will gain vital data. The foremost being a study of tidal changes within the Laguna Madre. Changes can refer to time, depth, and duration of low and high tidal periods. Water quality reports provide insight on which reliable materials should be used within a hypersaline lagoon, such as the Laguna Madre, and which vegetation is most suited for the area. Wave action reports show the range of impact on a typical day, inclement weather, and projected storm occurrences. This will help determine the strength at which the berms will be constructed and the maturity of plants chosen. A marine bathymetry report will depict the current bay floor and how the floor will change over time due to currents and other stressors. LiDar can be used for marine bathymetry to develop an accurate 3D representation and gather information on distance profiling for tidal elevation mapping. Aerial photos will be used to provide the best location for the placement of berms, outlay of project boundary, and tidal fluctuations. Coastal profiling aids in the comparison of erosion rates, project projection outcomes, and severe weather event modeling. A marine vegetation report encompasses which plants should thrive within the workspace. A biological report will be done to determine which species will be impacted during the project, the lowest impact ideals will be used through this reporting. A mitigation plan will be drafted to adhere to government requirements and regulations. A preliminary design concept(s) will be reviewed extensively with NFWF and the TGLO to promote the most effective coastal resiliency, habitat restoration, lowest impact, and community protection. Monitoring will take place via monthly data reports on all scopes of work along with quarterly data compilation. Annual reporting will occur post project completion.

2. **Project Outcome**(s): Describe expected short-term outcomes/results as well as the expected long-term utility of the project and its implications for future research, management, or conservation activities.

Short-term outcomes include data collection, compiled results, monitoring efforts, plausible designs, appropriate berm locations, and further community involvement.

Long-term outcomes include forward momentum with project design and implementation, continual data monitoring and shared data access, an increase of ecological niches, a decrease of community risk and coastal erosion, and an increase of bay management understanding. These outcomes will help with future research regarding sea-level rise, coastal erosion, and efforts for preparedness with critical coastal events. Living Shoreline Management will improve the increased understanding of effective methods and how to build upon success learned through the feasibility studies. Conservation activities will continue to grow using green structuring to further develop beneficial shoreline ecology and human safety.

3. Proposed Activities: Briefly describe your strategy (activities) for achieving the project outcome(s) and where you are in their planning and implementation.

Planning and Implementation can be defined into two categories Pre-award and Post-award, if selected.

Pre-award: Stakeholder support by two Tier 1 projects from the Texas General Land Office. Prior, the GLO's Technical Advisory Committee, with the City of South Padre Island met throughout the year for project input. Projects were prioritized through the City Council and approved for the Texas General Land Office. This shows support for the project's interest, and development, and community involvement. Approval for pre-application was reviewed and submitted by the City's Shoreline Department.

Post-award: Will involve the City posting a request for proposals out to research facilities and engineering firms. Scope of work contracts will be awarded to the selected parties. With approved communication from NFWF and the TGLO, feasibility research will be implemented. At this time project updates and deliverables will be submitted. The City will contact both working entities to provide updated study results and preliminary designs. The City plans to reach an agreement on preliminary designs within the allotted granting period among NFWF and TGLO approval.

As presented in the City of South Padre Island – Island Metro FY20 5311 CARES Act Grant Application, Island Metro will provide deviated fixed route service throughout the rural transit district service area.

Funding for this 5311 CARES Act project will enable the transit provider to continue operating established transit routes and to add new services to aid communities during the COVID-19 pandemic. Some services such as meal delivery and other critical services may be provided during this time. This project also provides for extra maintenance of transit buses including sanitizing, modifications for social distancing, and driver and other staff personal protective devices. The funds shall be used for rural area transit capital projects in each designated subrecipient's service area that may replace, rehabilitate and purchase buses and related equipment and to construct bus-related facilities including but not limited to technological changes or innovations to modify low or no emission vehicles or facilities.

Transit provider shall comply with Article 12: Project Records and Reports and Article 13 of the Master Grant Agreement requiring procurement and project milestones / quarterly progress reports. Within 30 days of PGA execution, the subrecipient will provide the TxDOT Public Transportation Coordinator with a project milestone plan that delineates fund expenditures throughout the contract period.

Per Texas Administrative Code (TAC) 31.47, Audit and Project Close-Out Standards: The subrecipient shall make every reasonable effort to complete all project activities and request appropriate reimbursements within the time period specified in the project agreement and TAC 9.136, Suspension or Termination for Cause: On termination of a subgrant, the unexpended and unobligated funds awarded to the subgrantee immediately revert to the department (TxDOT).

TxDOT's Public Transportation Division's (PTN) Federal Transit Administration overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal for fiscal years 2018 - 2020 is 2.9 percent of funds expended by grantees.
