PET-FRIENDLY ISLAND

The City of South Padre Island and the Friends of Animal Rescue recommend these helpful tips to keep your fur-babies safe!

If you lose or find a pet please call the 24-hour Friends of Animal hotline at (956) 772-1171.

- The City of South Padre Island has a strict leash law, so please leash your pets.
- Don't let your pets drink ocean water- it will upset their stomachs. Make sure to keep fresh water on hand.
- Use pet-friendly sunscreen to help protect them from sunburns. Provide shade when possible.
- The sand and pavement can get too hot for pet paws.
 Avoid taking your dogs out during peak sun times. If the sand or pavement is too hot for you, it is for them also.
- If you are visiting, bring your pet's proof of vaccination and a photo so that if your pet becomes lost, we can help reunite the two of you.
- Remember your animal's sensitive ears during fireworks
 Please keep your pets inside or secure during the firework shows.
