Dr. Ybarra earned his degree from Baylor College of Medicine and has lived on South Padre Island since 1994. He helped begin a satellite clinic with Valley Baptist in 2000 and has since opened his own Private Practice & Wellness Clinic, both right here on the Island.

In his 35 years as a physician, Dr. Ybarra has spent 30 of those years volunteering as EMS Medical Director. As Medical Director, he serves as the medical authority for all South Padre



Island Paramedics with any medical encounters occurring under his supervision or delegation. Of his work as director, Dr. Ybarra shared, "Paramedics/Fire and Police are our unsung heroes and I consider it a privilege to do my part as the leader of the EMS team."
