In the Spotlight this week is South Padre Island Fire Chief, Jim Pigg! Chief Pigg is an Indiana native who decided to make the Island home in 2001. He began his career with the South Padre Island Fire Department as a Firefighter/EMT in 2005, and was promoted to Fire Chief in 2020. Chief Pigg also serves as the City's Emergency Management Coordinator.

As Fire Chief, he leads a team of 30 personnel who all work to keep the community safe. One way they do so is by

preparing future generations of public safety officials through the Junior Lifeguard Program. The program gives Chief Pigg the opportunity to work with local kids by educating and developing them for any of their future endeavors.

As the City's Emergency Management Coordinator, Chief Pigg has been very busy preparing and managing this year's Spring Break. Although most of the team are Spring Break veterans, everyone still plans for the unexpected and preparations begin months in advance. The Emergency Operation Center is set up every Spring Break, serving as the command center for all departments, agencies and organizations assisting throughout this busy month.
