COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

A Regular City Council Meeting was held on Wednesday, April 20th. The meeting began with a presentation from Shoreline Director. Kristina Boburka, regarding updates on the Wind and Water Sports Park. As of today, the City and its partners are working on an updated design based off feedback from the US Army Corps of Engineers. The project has faced Wind & Water Sports Park site location



many obstacles along the way but the City continues to work diligently with its partners to bring this project to fruition.

From the Regular Agenda:

- Johnson Consulting presented an updated feasibility study on the Convention Centre Expansion Project which included designs, recommendations and future projections. Council voted to proceed with an RFQ (request for quotes) on the project.
- CFO Rodrigo Gimenez presented the City's Mid-Year Budget Review with highlights including:
 - Growing cash and investment balances.
 - Building permits doubled, resulting in a significant increase in license and permit revenue.
 - 16% increase in Sales and Hotel Tax revenue in comparison to the previous fiscal year.
- Council approved the design, construction phases, and budget amendment for the development of a Pickleball Court. Construction is estimated to begin this summer with majority of the work done in-house by the Public Works Department.






PET OF — THE WEEK
