

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

A Regular City Council Meeting was held on Wednesday, May 4th. Mayor Patrick McNulty announced that City Manager Randy Smith was the recipient of the Texas Crisis Intervention Team Award at this year's conference, held right here on South Padre Island! He went on to recognize City staff (pictured above) who contributed to bringing significant conferences to be hosted on SPI.

From the Regular Agenda:

- Council discussed the Short-Term Rental (STR) and Noise Ordinances, voting to receive regular updates from staff regarding noise complaints, STR registrations, and compliance. Additionally, a notice will be sent to STR owners/managers reminding them of the City's STR policies and ordinances.
- Ryan O'Byren was appointed to fill a vacancy on the Special Events Committee.
- Nancy Berkley, from Evergreen Solutions LLC, presented a Compensation Study & Plan, which provided data and recommendations regarding the City's pay plans. Council voted to adjust the City's pay scale so it's more competitive and in line with neighboring municipalities.
- The June 15th Regular City Council Meeting has been rescheduled to a Special City Council Meeting on Wednesday, June 22nd.

Breta is a German Shepard from Germany who was trained as a single-purpose dog for narcotics detection. She's served with the South Padre Island Police Department for nearly 7 of her 8 years of life. In her career, she's not only assisted SPIPD with searches, but also other agencies including the FBI, DEA, Port Isabel PD, plus many more.


