ouncil Members and Public Works Department for the National Public Works Week Proclamation

This week's regular City Council Meeting was cancelled and a Special Council Meeting was held today, Friday May 20.

After Public Comments, Mayor Mcnulty made a Proclamation in honor of National Public Works Week. The City's infrastructure, facilities, and services could not be provided without the dedicated efforts of our Public Works (PW) Department. Their work is of vital importance to our community and for public health. Thanks PW!

From the Regular Agenda:

- City staff shared that since the last Council meeting, there has been 163 new and renewed permits regarding shortterm rentals.
- Resolution No. 2022-06 was approved to appoint Rigoberto Flores for the Municipal Court Judge 2 position.
- Items 6.4 & 6.5 were both approved, allowing the Whitecap Circle Beach Access Improvements project to begin soon.

C. Alejandro Sanchez, P.E., CFM! Alex was born in Brownsville, Texas
