PFT TIPS

TIP #1: South Padre Island mandates that animals must be on a leash at all times. Make sure to always leash your pet to keep them safe.

TIP #2: Ocean water can make your pet's stomach upset. Don't allow your pet to drink ocean water.

TIP #3: Avoid taking your pet out during peak sunny times. The pavement can be very hot which can cause discomfort.

TIP #4: Bring your pets vaccination records with you. If you lose your pet they cannot be released without proof of a rabies vaccination.

TIP #5: If you lose your pet, call Friends of Animal Rescue (FOAR) immediately. Lost pets are taken there by animal control.

Here are some highlights from the March 1st Regular City Council Meeting!

- Approved temporary closure of Hwy 100 and a portion of the Queen Isabella Causeway Memorial Bridge for the 39th Annual Causeway Run and Fitness Walk on April the 15th 2023.
- Approved temporary closure of Hwy 100 and a portion of the Queen Isabella Causeway Memorial Bridge for the 39th Annual Causeway Run and Fitness Walk on April the 15th 2023.
- Approved Ordinance No. 23-03 to reduce the speed limit along PR 100 between South Padre Island North City Limits and 28 ft. South of Kings Court.
- Update and Presentation by the Atkins Group regarding Branding Refresh Project.
- Approved the Pickleball Design Concept Phase II.
- Approved the basketball court shade and solar lighting design concept for John L. Tompkins Park Phase III grant. This will then be sent to Texas Parks and Wildlife for review.

Short Term Rentals

In an effort to ensure compliance with all local ordinances, the City of South Padre Island provides a database of registered short-term rental properties. This database is available to the public on the City website.

Short-term vacation rentals can bring a positive economic impact to the City in several ways. For example, they contribute to Hotel Occupancy Tax revenues. At the same time, short-term rental guests benefit the local economy by spending money at other visitor-related amenities, such as restaurants and retail stores.
