Short Term Rental Update

Starting Monday May 1st, 2023 anyone who owns or operators a short term rental (STR) will need to obtain a short term rental license. This also extends to units bring advertised as short term rentals. The annual license fee will be \$125 per rental unit. All old and new short term rentals will need to be registered at www.myspi.org/hottax. After obtaining the license each unit will have their own license number issued. These fees will provide funding towards the new STR program and enforcement. View the press release here.
