Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve a budget transfer of \$45,000 from Excess Reserves in FY 21/22 to be used for the Marketing sponsorship for the Switch Up motion picture. Motion passed unanimously.

5.4. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO APPROVE THE AMENDED CVB STAFF INCENTIVE PAYMENT FOR FY 2020/2021 WITH A PRORATED AMOUNT BASED ON THE LENGTH OF EMPLOYMENT FOR EACH CVB EMPLOYEE DURING THE FISCAL YEAR WITH THE MAXIMUM PAYMENT AMOUNT OF \$4,522.87. (MOORE)

Council Member Ricco made a motion, seconded by Council Member Schwartz to approve the amended CVB Staff Incentive payment for FY 21/22 with a prorated amount based on the length of employment for each CVB employee during the fiscal year with the maximum payment amount of \$4,522.87. Motion passed on a 3 to 1 vote with Council Member Medders casting a nay vote and Council Member Caballero abstaining from the vote.
