5. Discussion and action regarding Padre Boulevard design. (Staff, Dr. Kim)

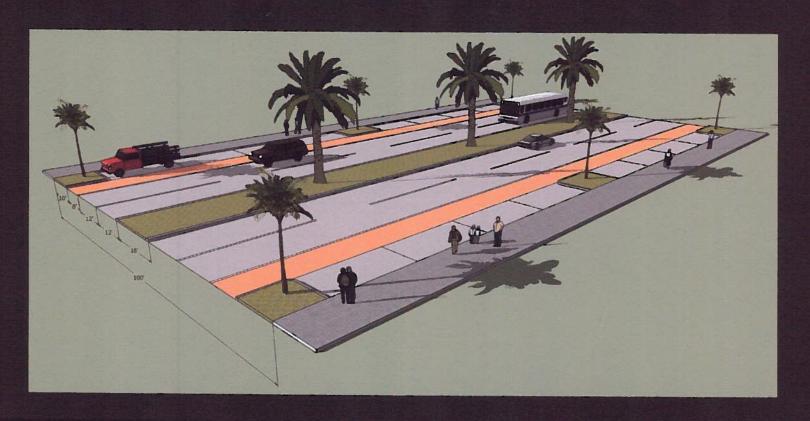
Mr. Fudge announced the item from the agenda and asked for a staff report. Dr. Kim gave a presentation regarding the Padre Boulevard design.

ITEM DESCRIPTION:

Discussion and action regarding a variance on color scheme for KFC building at 3201 Padre Blvd.

DISCUSSION:

On June 31, 2014, Mr. Cliff Beatenbough, on behalf of KBP Foods, applied for a variance on color scheme to incorporate KFC Corporation's Paint Specifications.

BACKGROUND HISTORY

Corporate/Franchise color issue was discussed earlier at the Planning & Zoning Commission on June 28, 2013, which motion passed 4 to 1, and at the City Council on July 17, 2013, which motion failed 3 to 3. At the Council meeting, the City Council directed staff to work with the DSRTF on the issue.

Through the April 8th workshop and the May 13th regular meeting, the DSRTF unanimously recommended the Planning and Zoning Commission approve the proposed revision of color palette.

At the June 19th P&Z meeting, the P&Z unanimously recommended the City County approve the proposed revision of color palette.

The City Council passed the amendment to the color palette at the first hearing on July 16, 2014 and at the second hearing on August 6, 2014.

However, the revised color palette does not contain provisions for Corporate/Franchise color.

COLOR ISSUE

The applicant proposes three (3) colors (Benjamin Moore E-25 Mooreglo Heritage Red; Sherwin Williams #7048 Urbane Bronze; and Sherwin Williams #2123 White). Among those proposed, Benjamin Moore E-25, although it is rather pure in color than those in the City color palette, has similar colors within the range of earth tone. The proposed SW 7048 has similar colors in the City color palette (SW 7039 and SW 0038), and the proposed SW 2123 (white) is permitted by both the City color palette and Munsell Color System.

The building foot print is approximately 4,225 sq.ft and the City allows four (4) colors (for body, trim, accent and roof) up to 5,000 sq.ft. However, the issue here is that the applicant is proposing the three (3) colors for the building body. By doing so, the proposal also goes against the provision prohibiting pattern of stripes narrower than 20'.

The Paint Specifications provided by the applicant does not reflect the existing building and we cannot rely on it to review the color variance. On the other hand, it is noted that the applicant already painted the building without a permit and the DSRTF can review the color scheme on the basis of current

LOCATION ANALYSIS

The building is located in Padre Boulevard Central Zone that accommodates commercial on any floor and careful consideration of auto-oriented site elements, such as drive-through, surface parking and service areas. Residential uses are permitted on upper floors and ground floors along east-west street frontage. Considerations should be given to the fact that the area is mainly dedicated for commercial uses.

SWOT ANALYSIS

Strength: In addition to the What-a-Burger building, it helps forming a commercial path along Padre Blvd. This commercial path may assist the City in developing a future downtown.

Weakness: Existing Dairy Queen and BurgerFi are NOT located near providing no gravity for a future downtown.

Opportunities: By providing visual definition to the area, the commercial path may encourage non-residential developers to build their facilities in the area.

Threats: The area is getting colorful and we are expecting strip-mall type commercial developments.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the DSRTF review the proposed color scheme independently from the City color palette and approve the usage of the proposed color scheme. If there is a room to accommodate conditions, staff recommends earth-tone red instead of the proposed Benjamin Moore E-25.

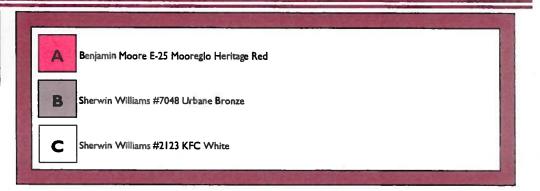

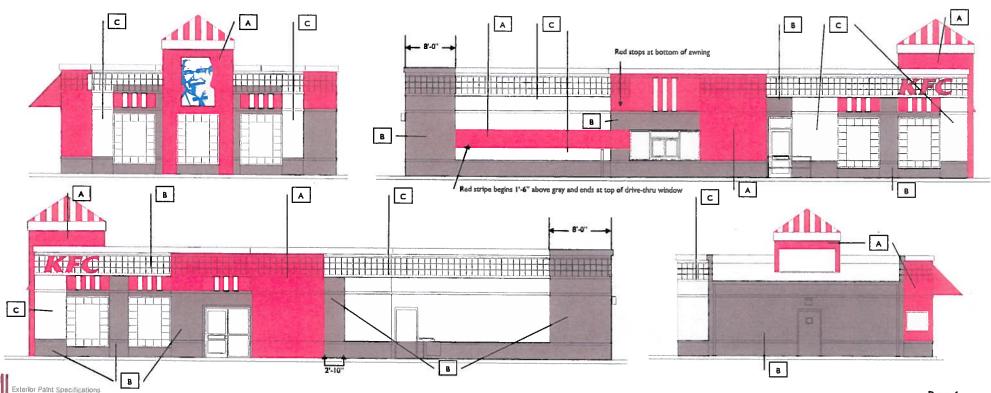
