1. Call To Order

Meeting was called to order at 4:00 pm by KSPIBC Chairwoman Susan Dalton.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Committee Member George led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. Public Comments and Announcements

Committee Chairwoman Dalton welcomed Sally Scaman who was present for the meeting.

4. Approval of minutes from September 9, 2015 meeting

Committee Chairwoman Dalton motioned to accept the minutes as written, and Committee Member George seconded. All voted in favor; motion carried unanimously.

5. <u>Discussion and action regarding:</u>

- A. KSPIB Archives (Elaine Sanchez)
 - Committee Member Sanchez informed everyone that Nancy Marsden (previous KSPIB member) gave her some beneficial articles regarding KSPIB. Most of the newspaper clippings stated how and when the KSPIBC was founded. Committee Member Dalton motioned to archive the articles on the OneDrive account. Committee Member Brotzman seconded.
