#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-33**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF AN GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE TO ELECT TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS (PLACE 1 AND PLACE 2) AND SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE AUTHORIZING A VENUE PROJECT TO BE FINANCED BY THE IMPOSITION OF AN ADDITIONAL 2% TAX INCREASE ON THE HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX IN THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS ON NOVEMBER 8, 2016.

**WHEREAS**, there came to be considered the returns of an General election held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 2016 for the purpose of electing two Council Members (Place 1 and Place 2) and a Special election to authorize a venue project to be financed by the imposition of an additional 2% tax increase on the Hotel Occupancy Tax; and

WHEREAS, City Council canceled the November 8, 2016 General election in accordance with Section 2.053(a) of the Texas Election Code to which the candidates have been certified as unopposed and are hereby elected as follows; and

General Election – to elect two Council Members (Place 1) and Council Member Place 2): Unopposed and declared elected

Candidate Office

Dennis Stahl Council Member – Place 1 Ron Pitcock Council Member – Place 2

WHEREAS, there came to be considered the returns of an election held on the 8th day of November 2016 for the purpose to authorize a venue project to be financed by the imposition of an additional 2% tax increase on the Hotel Occupancy Tax; and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election 1003 valid and legal votes; that each of the candidates in said election received the following number of votes:

Special Election – Authorizing the City of South Padre Island to provide for the planning, design, development, acquisition, renovation and construction of a convention center annex, Padre Boulevard medians and improvements,

amphitheater(s), improvements for sports and community venue projects and related land purchase, automobile parking facility and related land purchase or on land or facilities owned by the City of South Padre Island; and to impose a hotel occupancy tax at the rate of 2% for the purpose of financing the venue project. If approved, the maximum hotel occupancy tax rate imposed from all sources in the City of South Padre Island would be 16.5% of the price paid for a room in a hotel:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-35**

WHEREAS, Chapter 334 of the Local Government Code requires the City of South Padre Island establish by resolution a fund known as the "venue project fund"; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby establishes a fund known as the "venue project fund."

Section 2. Such fund shall have separate accounts within the fund for the various revenue sources in accordance with Local Government Code chapter 334.042.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 16-23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 17, BY ADDING A NEW SEC. 17-17 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND PERTAINING TO HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX ("HOT") BY ADDING A NEW VENUE TAX WHICH SHALL INCREASE THE HOT BY 2%; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN CAPTION FORM.

WHEREAS, the City of South Padre Island City Council (the "City Council") sought approval from the voters of a venue project as authorized by Chapter 334 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City called a special tax election to submit a measure to the voters providing for the imposition of a hotel occupancy tax to be used for a venue project, and the votes passed the measure; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances of the City of South Padre Island needs to be amended to reflect the recent changes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

**Section 1**. Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of South Padre Island is amended by adding a new section, Sec. 17-17, as follows:

### "Sec. 17-17 Venue Tax on hotel-motel occupancy tax.

- a) There is hereby levied an additional venue tax of two (2%) percent, which is in addition to the hotel-motel occupancy tax already levied, on a person who, under lease, concession, permit, right of access, license, contract, or agreement, pays for the use or possession or for the right to the use or possession of a room that is in a hotel, costs Two Dollars (\$2.00) or more each day, and is ordinarily used for sleeping.
- b) The administration and enforcement of this venue tax shall be in accordance with the hotel-motel occupancy tax provisions contained in Chapter 17, Article II.
- c) The maximum combined hotel occupancy tax rate from all sources cannot exceed seventeen (17%) percent per Local Government Code 334.254.
- d) Each bill or receipt for a hotel charge shall comply with Local Government Code 334.256 and conspicuously state the applicable hotel occupancy tax rate collected for the State and the tax rate and identity of each other taxing authority that has imposed a hotel occupancy tax."
- **Section 2**. This ordinance repeals all portions of any prior ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Code of Ordinances in conflict herewith.
- **Section 3.** If for any reason any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, word or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by final judgment of a court
