Read this form carefully. Failure to complete the course will cause your license to be suspended or you will not be able to obtain one. An additional charge is also filed with a **WARRANT OF ARREST.**

For local listings of these **ALCOHOL** Awareness courses contact your local Municipal Court or check the Yellow Pages of your local telephone book. Courses may be listed under Defensive Driving or **ALCOHOL** Courses not to be confused with Alcoholics Anonymous. Do not attend an Alcoholics Anonymous meeting, it must be a course involving underage drinking or minor in possession of Alcohol.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LAWS:

ZERO TOLERANCE IN TEXAS

First Offense:

Class C Misdemeanor: up to \$500 fine, Attend ALCOHOL Awareness course, 8-12 hours of community service, 30 days driver's license suspension/denial.

Second Offense:

Class C Misdemeanor: up to \$500 fine, Possible ALCOHOL Awareness course, 20-40 hours of community service, 60 days driver's license suspension/denial.
