




Stormwater – Low Impact Development ("Green" Infrastructure)

ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

Project Phasing\Limit & Limitations

- Maximum number of street sections that can be closed at one time
- · Limitations on work week, weekends, holidays, special events, etc.
- Pavement Markings at Entertainment District (Additional handicap ramps with designated crosswalks from west side to east side of Laguna Blvd.)
 - Striping as one continues pedestrian crossing
 - Limit pedestrian crossing at intersections and/or mid crossings

ITEMS OF DISCUSSION

Bike delineation selections

- Areas without driveway/parking
 - 2" Traffic lane dividers
 - Zicla or similar 4" separator
 - 4" Plastic wheel stops
 - 4" concrete wheel stops
 - Flower beds

Areas with driveway/parking

- Green reflective raised marking
- Rumbel Strips
- 1"- 2.5" Speed Bump
