Traffic management plan for the Walk for Women and SPI TRI

South Padre Island, TX, Oct. 3, 2017: South Padre Island is excited to welcome back the 14th Annual Walk for Women and the SPI TRI. Both events are scheduled for this Sunday, Oct. 8.

The South Padre Island Police Department along with other City departments will be working together to manage personnel and traffic control barrels and cones that will be placed in areas to enhance the flow of traffic.

“Public Safety is our number one priority,” said Randy Smith, police chief. “We want to ensure the participants and visitors enjoy this event.”

Expect traffic delays before and after the SPI TRI and the Walk for Women on Sunday, Oct. 8, 2017. Beginning at 7 a.m. through 1 p.m.

Personnel will place traffic control barrels/cones on the roadway to direct traffic movement and to minimize delays. The details of the traffic control are as follows:

SPI TRI Event will begin at 7 a.m.

1. Northbound traffic will be detoured from the intersection 5800 block Padre Boulevard and East Palmetto. Traffic will be directed towards East Palmetto and connect to Havana Street.
2. Southbound traffic will be detoured from the intersection of 6000 block Padre Boulevard and East Sunset Street. Traffic will be directed towards East Sunset and connect to Havana Street.

Walk for Women Event will begin at 10 a.m.

1. Orca Circle Drive south to West Amberjack Street.
2. West Amberjack Street towards Laguna Boulevard.
3. Laguna Boulevard heading south ending at West Ling and Laguna Boulevard.
