MINUTES CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2018

I. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council Members of the City of South Padre Island, Texas held a Regular Meeting on Wednesday, September 19, 2018 at the Municipal Complex Building, 2nd Floor, 4601 Padre Boulevard, South Padre Island, Texas. Mayor Stahl called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. A full quorum was present: Mayor Dennis Stahl, Council Members Ken Medders, Jr., Theresa Metty and Paul Munarriz. Council Members Ron Pitcock and Alita Bagley were out with an excused absence.

VII. **DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO CONTRIBUTE \$50,000 FROM GENERAL FUND EXCESS RESERVES TO THE FRIENDS OF ANIMAL RESCUE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN. (STAHL)**

Mayor Stahl made a motion, seconded by Council Member Munarriz to approve the contribution of \$50,000 from General Fund Excess Reserves to the Friends of Animal Rescue Capital Campaign. Motion passed unanimously.

VIII. DISCUSSION AND ACTION TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO G&T PAVING, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$297,086.90 FOR THE 2018 SIDE STREET IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II ON WEST GEORGIA RUTH DRIVE, THE WEST 425' OF EAST MARS LANE, WEST MARS LANE AND WEST POLARIS DRIVE BASE BID AND ADD ALTERNATIVE BID 2 (POST AND ROPE REINSTALL ON WEST GEORGIA RUTH), APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT FOR \$325,000 TO ALLOW FOR POTENTIAL CHANGE ORDERS, AUTHORIZE THE ASSISTANT CITY MANAGER TO APPROVE CHANGE ORDERS NOT TO EXCEED THE BUDGET AMOUNT AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT. (JONES)

Council Member Medders made a motion to award contract to G & T Paving for the 2018 Side Street Improvements Phase II project in the amount of \$297,086.90, approve budget amendment in the amount of \$325,000 for potential changes orders, authorize the Assistant City Manager to approve change orders and authorize the City Manager to execute the contract. Council Member Metty seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

IX. APPROVE A BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,019.56 TO COVER TESTING SERVICES FOR THE 2018 STREET WIDENING IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 2 ON WEST GEORGIA RUTH DRIVE, THE WEST 425' OF EAST MARS LANE, WEST MARS LANE AND WEST POLARIS DRIVE. (JONES)

Mayor Stahl made a motion to approve a budget amendment to cover testing services for the 2018 Street Widening Improvements Phase 2 project in the amount of \$11,019.56. Motion was seconded by Council Member Munarriz. Motion passed on a unanimous vote.

X. PUBLIC HEARING: TO DISCUSS SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS PARKS AND WILDLIFE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR "NON-URBAN OUTDOOR GRANT" FUNDS TO COMPLETE PHASE II OF JOHN L. TOMPKINS PARK. (CROSS)
