Traffic management plan for SPI's Mariachi Run

South Padre Island, TX, Oct. 30, 2018: South Padre Island is excited to bring a Mariachi Run that celebrates the history of the Mariachi. This 5k and 10k run is scheduled for Saturday, Nov 3, 2018.

"Public Safety is our primary focus," said Randy Smith, police chief. "Our goal is to ensure everyone stays safe and has a good time while running this course."

Expect traffic delays before and after the event. This event will begin at 5:30 p.m. and is expected to end at 7 p.m. It will start and end at 33261 State Park Road 100.

City departments will be working together to manage crowds and traffic control. The City may place traffic control barrels/cones on the roadway to direct traffic movement and to minimize delays.

Vehicles

- 1. All northbound traffic will merge into the left lane beginning at <u>700 Padre Blvd.</u> and State Park Road 100.
- 2. All southbound traffic will be unobstructed.

Runners/Walkers

- 1. The run will begin at 5:30 p.m. and start at <u>33261 State Park Road 100</u>, turn right onto Padre Boulevard and head northbound to Padre Boulevard Frontage Road.
- 2. Participants will take a right at <u>700 Padre Blvd. and State Park Road 100</u> and head northbound to East Haas Street.
- 3. Then runners will turn right heading eastbound on Haas Street and turn left on Gulf Boulevard.
- 4. Runners will head northbound until 10 yards past Neptune Circle and turn around to head back to <u>33261 State Park Road 100</u>.
