

Boil Water Notice Rescinded
July 25, 2019

On July 24, 2019, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the Laguna Madre Water District public water system, PWS ID: 0310005, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The public water system has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by this public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of July 25, 2019, 2:00 p.m. Bacteriological samples from lab came back negative, results received at 2:00 pm.
