Traffic management plan for the Walk for Women and SPI Pride Parade

South Padre Island, TX, Oct. 10, 2019: South Padre Island is excited to welcome back the 16th Annual Walk for Women and the SPI Pride Parade. Both events are scheduled for this Sunday, Oct. 13.

The South Padre Island Police Department along with other City departments will be working together to manage personnel and traffic control barrels and cones that will be placed in areas to enhance the flow of traffic.

“Public Safety is our number one priority,” said Claudine O’Carroll, Police chief. “We want to ensure the participants and visitors enjoy this event.”

Expect traffic delays before and after the Walk for Women and the SPI Pride Parade on Sunday, Oct. 13, 2019. Beginning at 9 a.m. through 3 p.m.

Personnel will place traffic control barrels/cones on the roadway to direct traffic movement and to minimize delays. The details of the traffic control are as follows:

Walk for Women Event will begin at 10 a.m.

1. Orca Circle Drive south to West Amberjack Street.
2. West Amberjack Street towards Laguna Boulevard.
3. Laguna Boulevard heading south ending at West Ling and Laguna Boulevard.

SPI Pride Parade Event will begin at 2 p.m.

1. Depart from Mars Street (SPI Post Office) heading southbound
2. Ending at Dolphin Street
3. Padre Boulevard southbound vehicle traffic will be diverted to Laguna Boulevard.
4. Padre Boulevard northbound lanes will remain unobstructed
