City of SPI recognized for commitment to Environmental Health

South Padre Island, TX, Nov. 21, 2019: The Texas Environmental Health Association (TEHA) has awarded the City of South Padre Island Environmental Health Services Department (EHSD) the Ruth Hendy Award of Excellence in Food Safety. EHSD primarily ensures the food safety of local restaurants and provides related training for servers and handlers working in city restaurants.

TEHA is a state association that strives to protect and strengthen the status of the environmental health profession. The Award of Excellence recognizes entities that achieve a high degree of professionalism and commitment to the communities they serve.

“We are extremely honored to receive this award for the fifth time,” said J. Victor Baldovinos, Environmental Health director. “This award would not be possible without the local restaurants continued support.”

To achieve this status, affiliates must share information on their food and beverage program, covering activity over the past year in which sustained improvements and excellence are demonstrated.
