**ORDER RESCINDING THE SECOND AMENDED
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ORDER REGARDING
BEACH OPERATIONS**

WHEREAS, I, Patrick McNulty, Mayor of South Padre Island issued the Emergency Management Order Regarding Beach Operations on March 16, 2020, under Section 418.0147 of the Texas Government Code that the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) poses an imminent threat of disaster for all counties in the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, that extraordinary emergency measures must be taken to mitigate the effects of this public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 hospitalizations and the rate of new COVID-19 cases have steadily declined due to vaccinations, improved medical treatments for COVID-19 patients, abundant supplies of testing and personal protective equipment and residents, businesses, and visitors' adherence to safe practices like social distancing, hand sanitizing, and the use of face coverings; and


WHEREAS, Governor of Texas Greg Abbott has issued Executive Order GA-34 relating to the opening of Texas in response to the COVID-19 disaster; and

THEREFORE, I, Mayor Patrick McNulty do hereby rescind the second amended Emergency Management Order Regarding Beach Operations effective at 12:01 a.m. on Wednesday, March 10, 2021.
