No yelling, no weapons out, no yellow tape, no yelling at passersby, just calm conversation with the person in question, despite obvious provocations, a couple of officers in the back, two other female officers engaged in deescalating the situation and no aggression. A few minutes later it's all over. Everyone goes their way. Safely and calmly. An exceptionally professional and well trained force."
