In the Spotlight this week is South Padre Island Chief of Police, Claudine O'Carroll! Chief O'Carroll was born and raised in Athlone County, Westmeath, Ireland and immigrated to America in 1992. She served in the United States Coast Guard before graduating the police academy in 1998. She joined the South Padre Island Police Department the same year, climbing the ranks until eventually becoming the City's first female Chief of Police.

In her time serving the community of South Padre Island, Chief O'Carroll has worked as a patrol officer, investigator and in special operations. Her experience has molded her into a great leader of the department, where she's now able to develop the next generation of officers.

With Spring Break upon us, the Chief and her team are well prepared for the influx of visitors drawn to South Padre Island. PD will implement numerous safety measures to better serve the community such as social media monitoring, adding a sky tower in the Entertainment District, and using drones to monitor traffic.
