Lane Closures Planned for Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway on August 24

August 22, 2022

CAMERON COUNTY — A routine inspection of the Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway will require temporary lane closures, on Wednesday, August 24.

To minimize interruptions to traffic flow, TxDOT maintenance crews will first close the outside eastbound lane for inspection of the eastbound side of the Causeway. Following the eastbound inspection, the eastbound outside lane will re-open and the westbound outside lane of the bridge will close for the westbound assessment.

This routine inspection will be completed in one day and all lanes of the Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway will be open for the Labor Day weekend.
