South Padre Island Dog Park - Business Plan (DRAFT 9/21/22_Beggs)

Executive Summary

There are currently no leash free dog parks on South Padre Island (SPI) for residents, visitors and tourist use. SPI needs a clean, secure and safe environment for dogs on SPI to get the exercise and socialization they need. Having a dog park will be beneficial to all dogs, their humans and may promote tourism to the island.

Mission

Establish a fenced in, off leash aesthetically pleasing dog park on SPI where well behaved dogs and their humans can exercise in a clean and safe environment without endangering people, property or wildlife. This space will be developed and maintained with benches, shade, bathroom facilities and have controlled access. Access to the park will only be permitted for dogs that have been fully vetted. Additionally, a dog park like this will draw visitors interested in traveling with their pets and having a desirable and safe place for dogs to socialize and exercise off leash.

This space must be/include:

- Property 1/2 acre or more and in compliance with all zoning requirement (1 acre is desirable to accommodate all elements.
- Separate areas for small (20 pounds and under) and large dogs
- ADA compliant
- Parking
- Restrooms Facility
- Fenced space with double gate entry
- Covered shaded area
- Electricity / lighting
- Potable Water
- Moving water feature / splash pad
- Dog Waste disposal stations
- Controlled Access
- Aggressive Dogs remediation
- Insurance
- Maintenance
- Signage / Rules
- Funding / Budget

The space should include:

- Benches
- Shade features
- Rain water catchment system for watering grass *
- Sprinkler / irrigation system attached to but not solely dependent on the rain water catchment .

Property

The space must be a minimum of 1/2 acre and meet all legal and zoning requirements.

This space will include a moving water feature, space for ball throwing, and space for agility training. XXX.

ADA Compliant -

All space including parking, restroom facility, and fenced space must include wheelchair ramp(s) where necessary and must be ADA compliant.

Parking

A minimum of XXX parking spaces including XXX number of wheelchair accessible spaces.

The parking spaces must be well lit.

Restrooms Facilities

There must be a restroom facility with toilets, sinks, hot (???) and cold running water.

The restroom facility must be secure to discourage illegal activities (vandalism, camping) and undesirable behaviors.

Fenced space

The space must be securely enclosed with minimum 5 feet high vertical fence and must be **double gated** to ensure dog and human safety.

Fences around dog park should be at least 5 feet tall, footings should be buried at least one foot down, and fence panels to a depth of six inches with he exception of the access gates.

Fenced space will not include the bathroom and parking spaces.

Covered shaded area

There must be a large shaded area included in the fenced space for dogs and their humans.

Electricity / lighting

There must be electricity in the space to ensure safety. The space will be lighted with flood lights or string lights and will automatically be on dusk to dawn.

Water

The space must include clean potable drinking water for dogs and their humans.

This space should include a moving water feature / splash pad and any grey water will be used to water grass.

Dog Waste disposal stations

The space including the enclosed fenced area, parking area and restroom facility must include an adequate number of dog waste disposal stations which includes waste bags and garbage cans.

Controlled Access

The fenced space (and restroom facility???) must be securely locked nighty and opened each morning. Humans with approved access must not be able to enter the fenced space (and restroom facility???) when the park is closed.

All dogs entering the fenced space must be fully vetted before their human(s) may have key ??? access. For humans with more than one dog, each dog must be vetted separately. This vetting must include all of the following:

- Acceptance of Dog Park Rules all humans entering the space must sign acceptance of all dog park rules. XXX
- Vaccinated- Yearly records from a qualified veterinarian for each dog entering space to confirm dogs have been vaccinated for parvovirus, distemper, Bordetella bronchiseptica canine hepatitis, and rabies . ??? XXX
- Spayed/Neutered Proof from a qualified veterinarian that every dog entering space has been sprayed/neutered.
- Non aggressive Dogs may not be an aggressive dog breed (???) or be aggressive.
- Insurance waiver all humans entering the space must sign an insurance waiver of liability (???) and are fully responsible for the actions of their dog(s). XXX
- Adults only no one under the age of 18 (???) may enter the fenced space unless accompanied by an adult.
- Fee ?? A fee will be collected for daily/weekly/monthly/yearly access to the dog park to ensure dog owner responsibility and adherence to the rules.

• Dogs must be at least 6 months old to enter space and fully vetted.

Aggressive Dogs Remediation

No aggressive dog will be allowed in the park.

Insurance

The city must maintain an insurance policy in the amount of XXX which covers XXXXX

Maintenance

The space must be maintained by the city to include:

- All garbage picked up daily. This includes restroom facility, dog waste stations and parking area
- All space including restroom facility, fenced area and parking area sprayed daily with 30/1 bleach mixture for hard surfaces and XXX for porous and grass to help prevent spreading of parvo and other dog diseases
- Ensure no stickers, grass burrs
- Waste bags replenished daily
- Restroom facility cleaned daily and paper products replenished
- Landscaped XXX

Signage / Rules

The Dog Park rules must be displayed on sign(s) and must include human responsibilities:

- Hours of Operation
- Dog owner humans are responsible for picking up their dog's waste and their trash and disposing properly
- Humans entering the space are responsible for actions of their dogs.
- No aggressive behavior will be tolerated (dogs and humans).
- The access requirements (yearly approval)
- Not open to the public. Dogs must be vetted before humans are issued a key or other access
- How to gain access to the space- City telephone number or address?
- No unattended children or dogs
- No loud music
- No dog or puppy dumping




