PORT ISABEL/SOUTH PADRE ISLAND – A TxDOT hired contractor performing maintenance work on the Queen Isabella Memorial Causeway has requested additional time to finalize work on the bridge deck.

The work was originally slated for completion by the end of the February. The completion date has now shifted to March 7, 2023. The Causeway is expected to fully re-open by March 8.

Maintenance crews are currently completing work on the westbound lanes of the Causeway.

Drivers traveling through this work zone are advised to be extra cautious. They should reduce speed, maintain a safe following distance and be prepared for traffic to slow or come to a sudden stop.
