A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS, CANVASSING RETURNS AND DECLARING RESULTS OF A GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE TO ELECT TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS (MAYOR AND PLACE 4) FOR THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS ON NOVEMBER 7, 2023.

WHEREAS, there came to be considered the returns of the general election held on the 7th day of November 2023 for the purpose of electing two Council Member (Mayor and Council Member Place 4); and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election 813 valid and legal votes for the municipal election; that each of the candidates in said elections received the following number of votes: and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL MEMBERS OF THE CITY OF SOUTH PADRE ISLAND, TEXAS:

Section 1: That a General election was duly called, that notice of said election was duly posted in accordance with the laws of the Texas Election Code, that Patrick McNulty was elected Mayor and that Rees Langston was elected Council Member Place 4; and said persons are hereby declared duly elected to said offices, subject to the taking of their oaths and filing sworn statements and oaths as required by the laws of the State of Texas.

Section 2: It is further found and determined that in accordance with the laws of the Texas Election Code, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at the Municipal Complex and the City's website at www.myspi.org, 4601 Padre Boulevard, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.
