September 11 Remembrance Ceremony



On Wednesday, September 11, the City of South Padre Island Fire Station held a Remembrance Ceremony in honor of the victims and first responders who lost their lives on September 11, 2001, at the World Trade Center. The ceremony commenced with the Color Guard raising the United States flag and then lowering it to half-mast. Afterwards, Chief Jim Pigg gave a speech which was followed by a prayer from Captain Maxx Rodriguez and the Tolling of the Bell.



The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey dedicated a piece of steel from the World Trade Center to the SPI Fire Station. This piece of steel was recovered from the rubble of the World Trade Center and is dedicated to the almost 3,000 lives lost that day, including 60 law enforcement officers, and 343 firefighters. The artifact is permanently displayed at the base of the flag pole in front of the SPI Fire Station. Use this <u>link</u> to view more photos.
