Earth Day E-Waste Event

South Padre Island, TX, April 13, 2026: The City of South Padre Island Environmental Health Services Department (EHSD) is hosting an Earth Day E-Waste Recycling Event on Saturday, April 18, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. at the Community Center, located at 4501 Padre Boulevard.

The Environmental Protection Agency reports that United States consumers and businesses annually discard about 2.9 million tons of cell phones, computers, hard copy peripherals (including printers, scanners, and faxes), and televisions.

Approximately thirty-eight percent of these electronics were collected for recycling, with the remainder disposed of primarily in landfills, where precious metals cannot be recovered. Chemicals such as lead, cadmium, and mercury in e-waste are extremely hazardous to our health. EHSD and its partners aim to provide a safe, responsible way to recycle unwanted electronics.

“This is a great opportunity for our community to dispose of electronics properly,” said J. Victor Baldovinos, Environmental Health director. “By participating, we are reducing the negative impact that improper e-waste disposal would otherwise have on our delicate environment.”

Participating vendors are Dairy Queen, Friends of Animal Rescue, RDA Technologies, Republic Services, and Sea Turtle Inc.
